He has translated nearly all the principle writings of Manto into English in several volumes, including *Kingdom's End*, *Partition*, *Mottled Dawn*, *A Wet Afternoon*, *Letters to Uncle Sam*, and *Stars From Another Sky*. With an illustrious career in the communications media and government, Mr. Khalid Hasan is one of the most prominent and respected intellectuals from South Asia.
