Li Cheng is a Fellow of the Woodrow Wilson International Center for Scholars, Washington D.C. and Professor of Government at Hamilton College, New York. He received an M.A. in Asian Studies at the University of California, Berkeley, and a Ph.D. in Political Science at Princeton University. In 1993-95, Dr. Li worked in China as a Fellow of the U.S.-based Institute of Current World Affairs. In China, Dr. Li had the opportunity to interview political and business leaders as well as people from everyday walks of life. Based on this experience, he published, *Rediscovering China: Dynamics and Dilemmas of Reform*. His latest book is *China's Leaders: The New Generation*. Dr. Li is currently working on two book manuscripts: *Chinese Technocrats* and *Urban Subcultures in Shanghai*.
