Minxin Pei is Senior Associate and Co-Director of the China Program at the Carnegie Endowment for International Peace where his primary research focus is on the interaction of economic and political reform in China. Previously, he was an assistant professor in the Department of Politics at Princeton University. He is the author of *From Reform to Revolution: The Demise of Communism in China and the Soviet Union* (Harvard University Press, 1994) and has been published in a number of journals including *Foreign Policy*, *The National Interest*, *China Quarterly*, *Journal of Democracy*. Dr. Pei received his B.A. from Shanghai International Studies University; his M.F.A. from the University of Pittsburgh; and his M.A. and Ph.D. from Harvard University.
