Hatem Atallah became Ambassador of Tunisia to the United States on Oct. 19, 2000. In 1994, Ambassador Atallah served as Ambassador of Tunisia to South Africa, Mozambique, Zambia, Namibia, Angola and Zimbabwe until 1996, when he was promoted to minister plenipotentiary. Ambassador Atallah earned a diploma of sociology of development from the University of Arts of Tunis (1978) and a master’s degree in English literature from the University of Tunis.

Mr. Sadiq joined the Embassy of Pakistan, Washington D.C. as Minister/Deputy Chief of Mission in August 2002. In his diplomatic postings, Mr. Sadiq had served as Political Counsellor in Beijing and Brussels, as well as Second Secretary in Belgrade. Mr. Sadiq holds two Masters Degrees, in Political Science and International Affairs respectively from University of Peshawar, Pakistan and Columbia University, New York.
