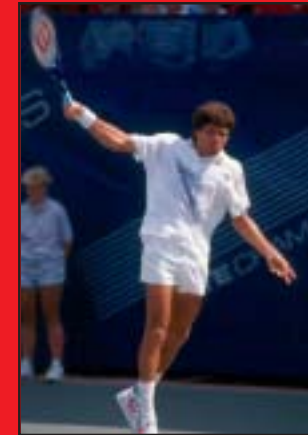

American University Head Men's Tennis Coach **Martin Blackman** has junior and pro coaching experience from the national junior level to the Division I NCAA collegiate level.

The three-time league coach of the year has led the Eagles to two straight Patriot League titles and a pair of trips to the NCAA Tournament. In 2002, his squad set a school record for wins in a season

with a 19-2 showing. Once a professional on the ATP Tour, Blackman was ranked among the top 150 competitors in the world. He competed in all four Grand Slams and won nine professional events. A member of the 1988 and 1989 Stanford University NCAA Championship Teams and MVP of the 1988 team, Blackman trained with Jim Courier, Pete Sampras and Andre Agassi. He was a member of the U.S. Junior Davis Cup Team from 1986-89 and was the winner of four National Junior titles, including Kalamazoo, the National Boys 16-under singles and doubles with Michael Chang.

Blackman is currently serving a two-year term on the USTA Board of Directors, 2003-2004.



After finishing out a stellar career at American University, **Kyle Bailey** is currently the Assistant Coach at AU. Bailey is also in his second year as Head Professional at Sutton Racquet Club.

While at AU he captained the team to two straight Patriot League Conference Championships and a pair of NCAA Tournament berths. During this time the Eagles also obtained their first ever

national ranking of No. 69 from the ITA in the country. He was an all league member and team MVP his senior year. He finished his career second in all-time singles wins and first in all-time doubles wins. Bailey also excelled in the classroom as he was a two-time Patriot League Honor Roll and Dean's List recipient.
