Head Coach Melissa McFerrin comes to American from the University of Minnesota, where she was an Associate Head Coach for the previous two seasons and was responsible for coordinating the Golden Gophers' offense and recruiting efforts. During her two-year tenure, McFerrin helped the UM teams to a combined 50-15 record and a trip to the NCAA Sweet 16 in 2003 and the Final Four in 2004. Both of McFerrin's recruiting classes were ranked top-20 nationally. McFerrin spent five seasons in the WNBA ranks prior to her time at Minnesota, beginning as an assistant coach with the New York Liberty. In her inaugural season in New York, McFerrin helped guide the Liberty to a runner-up showing. She spent three seasons with the Washington Mystics, including her final two seasons as General Manager. In McFerrin's first season as GM, the Mystics made the 2000 WNBA playoffs.
