American University is coached by **Shann Hart** (Norfolk State '88), who is in her fourth season leading the Eagles, and seventh overall as a collegiate head coach. Hart has a career record of 116-86 [.574]. Hart led American to 18 wins last season, the most since the 1997-98 season. She is assisted by **Glenn Rigney** (Miami '79), **Deb Reardon** (Assumption '86), **Brian Johnson** (Drexel '98) and graduate manager **Quintina Walker** (William & Mary '02).

Liberty is coached by **Carey Green** (Coastal Carolina '79), who is in his fifth season with the Flames. Green owns a career record of 96-38 (.716), all with Liberty. Green is assisted by **Chris Carroll**, **Kelley Deyo** and **Heather Shaffner**.

## LAST TIME OUT

Chanel Hunt scored a season-high 17 points and grabbed three rebounds, but it was not enough as the Eagles lost to Kent State by five, 57-52. American is now 5-6.

In the second half, the Eagles clamped down defensively and managed to chip away at a 10-point halftime deficit. AU held Kent State to just 31.8 percent shooting and outrebounded the Golden Flashes 22-16. American closed to within one point (47-46) on a pair of free throws by Joanna Barnes with 3:45 remaining in the game. Kent State built it back up to five, but Hunt drove to the basket for a layup with 34 seconds remaining to again bring AU to within one (53-52). However, it was the last points AU would score, and Kent State closed out the game with four straight free throws.

Barnes scored 13 points, including three threes, for the Eagles and tied Kim Salem for rebounding honors with seven apiece. Kaitlin Schuyler finished with 11 points, four rebounds and three assists while Chanel Spriggs chipped in with four points, three rebounds, three assists and three steals.

Kent State was led by Lindsay Shearer, who finished with 17 points and five rebounds while Andrea Csaszar finished with 11 points and nine rebounds.

## THE OPPONENT AND THE HISTORY

This is fifth meeting of American University and the Flames of Liberty University, with the Eagles holding a 4-0 record against LU entering this evening's contest. The two teams have not meet since Dec. 10, 1994, when AU defeated the Flames, 80-55. Liberty enters tonight's game with a 6-6 record, having just lost to undefeated Virginia Tech on Jan. 2, 52-45. The streaky Flames have not won or lost more than two consecutive games this season. Two of Liberty's losses have come in overtime, including a 74-70 defeat at the hands of No. 24 Boston College on Dec. 6, 2003.

## THAT'S THE TICKET!

Four of American's five wins this season have come when the Eagles shoot .400 or better. In each of AU's six losses, the Eagles have had a sub-.400 shooting night. The Eagles' only win when shooting below 40 percent came against the University of Maryland-Baltimore County on Dec. 18, a game in which AU forced 25 Retriever turnovers and allow UMBC to shoot just 37 percent.

## ON THIS DATE

The Eagles defeated former Colonial Athletic Association foe UNC Wilmington, 96-75, on Jan. 6, 1986. The win was part of the Eagles' first-ever 20 win season, in which they finished 20-7. The 1985-86 season ended in heartbreaking fashion, with AU losing to East Carolina University 69-68 in the second round of the CAA tournament.

## UP NEXT

American launches its Patriot League docket on Jan. 10 with a home contest against Bucknell beginning at 3 p.m. The game is the second half of a doubleheader, with the men facing Bucknell beginning at 1 p.m.

## HOME, SWEET HOME

AU women's basketball has accumulated a 116-79 (.595) record in the friendly confines of Bender Arena, since the facility opened its doors on Jan. 23, 1988. American has had a winning home record in 12 of the last 13 seasons, going 102-51 (.667) during that span. Last season, the Eagles racked up 10 wins against just two losses in Bender. American hosts 12 regular season home games this season. The Eagles opened up Bender in style so far this season, with wins over UNC Asheville and Howard, but have struggled since, losing to Elon on Dec. 30 and Kent State on Jan. 4.

## THREE-POINT THREAT

With three three-point field goals versus William & Mary on Dec. 20, senior guard **Kaitlin Schuyler** moved into second all-time on the school's career three-point field goals made list. The three treys gave her 106 in her career, surpassing 2003 graduate Maria Werries, who had 105, for second place. Schuyler would have to hit more than two three-pointers per game for the remaining 19 regular season contests to surpass the school record of 147 three-pointers made, set by Kari Gaskins between 1995 and 1999. This season, Schuyler is averaging 1.8 three-pointers made per game. Schuyler has hit 18 of her 53 attempts this season (.340), and more than half of her field goals come from outside the arc (18-of-33). For her career, she is averaging 1.3 three-pointers per game.

## PATRIOT LEAGUE PRESEASON PREDICTIONS

American has been selected by the Patriot League's coaches and sports information directors to finish second in the league. Ten-time Patriot League regular season champion Holy Cross was selected to win the league this year. The Crusaders were a near-unanimous selection to win the regular season title, with 14 out of a possible 16 first-place votes and 98 points. The Eagles were selected second with 84 points.

Meanwhile, junior forward **Chanel Hunt** was selected by the league's coaches and SIDs to the 2003-04 Preseason All-Patriot League Team. She was joined by Courtney Davidson from Navy, Katie Macfarlane from Army, Maggie Fontana from Holy Cross and Desire Almind from Bucknell. Hunt was among the league leaders last season in scoring (14.4 ppg), rebounding (7.3 rpg), assists (2.5 apg), steals (2.5 spg) and field goal percentage (.507).

## HUNT(ING) 1,000 POINTS

After 11 games this season, junior forward **Chanel Hunt** has 765 career points (11.4 ppg), including 417 points last season (14.4 ppg). Hunt needs to average 14.7 ppg over the 16 remaining regular season games to reach the 235 points needed to attain 1,000 career points. Hunt is averaging 10.5 ppg so far this season, and is coming off a season-high 17 points in the loss against Kent State. If Hunt can attain her 14.4 ppg scoring average from last season, she will score her 1,000th point on Feb. 20, 2004, at home against Holy Cross. Hunt would be just the 11th Eagle in school history to reach four-digits in scoring. Felicia Young is the school's all-time leading scorer, with 1,708 points.

## SPRIGGS CHASES 1,000 POINTS

Senior guard Chanel Spriggs is also chasing down the 1,000-point barrier, albeit in a less traditional way. The 5-7 Sunderland, Md., native played her freshman season (1999-2000) at NCAA Division III St. Mary's College of Maryland. She scored 229 points that season (8.5 ppg), and has scored 709 points in her three seasons at American, giving her 938 career points. At Spriggs' current pace (she is averaging 11.0 ppg this season), she will reach 1,000 points at Holy Cross on Jan. 25.

## Scouting Report

**Liberty:** It's hard to miss the focal point of the Flames' offense and defense -- 6-8 senior center **Katie Feenstra**. The Michigan native is averaging 18.8 ppg, 9.9 rpg, 2.0 blocks per game and is shooting 68 percent from the floor. Feenstra has encountered foul trouble this season, fouling out of three of the Flames' 12 contests. Complementing Feenstra are a trio of players -- **Daina Staugaitiene**, **Rima Margeviciute** and **Kristal Tharp** -- who all average more than 7.0 ppg. Staugaitiene and Tharp make up the Flames' outside threat, hitting 31 percent and 25 percent of their three point attempts, respectively. Staugaitiene and **Monique Leonard** distribute the ball, with 54 and 40 assists, respectively.

## DISHING THE ROCK

Senior guard **Kaitlin Schuyler** has 262 assists in her three-plus seasons at AU, good for seventh all-time. She is just one assist from sixth-place. Schuyler passed out a career-high 83 assists (3.5 apg) in the 2001-02 season, and followed that up with 75 assists in 29 games (2.6 apg) last year. In her freshman campaign, Schuyler dished out 65 assists in 23 games (2.8 apg). For her career, Schuyler has given out 3.0 assists per game. If she continues on that pace, Schuyler has a chance to move into fourth place on the school's all-time career assists list, behind Danielle Blackburn (340), Karen Jenkins (396) and the school's all-time leader, Jody Thornton, who had 693 assists between 1983 and 1987. Schuyler leads the 2003-04 Eagles with 39 assists, including tallying seven dimes versus Mount St. Mary's.

## RIPPIN' 'EM DOWN

Junior Kim Salem, a 6-1 forward/center, has had a nose for the rebounds lately. Against Brown, the Oakville, Ontario, native chased down a career-high eight caroms, including four offensive boards. Then against Kent State, Salem battled with the Golden Flashes' 6-6 center Andrea Csaszar and held her own, snagging seven boards. Salem is now averaging 4.4 rebounds per game.

## WE PLAY, SHE STARTS

Senior shooting guard **Chanel Spriggs** has played in 66 games for American University since transferring from Div. III St. Mary's (Md.) after her freshman season (following the footsteps of Head Coach **Shann Hart**), and has started in each of those games. In addition to closing in on the school's all-time record for steals, Spriggs has scored 709 points in her two-plus seasons (10.8 ppg), hit nearly 48 percent of her shots and grabbed 324 rebounds (4.9 rpg).

## PAST SUCCESS = FUTURE SUCCESS?

If past results against the Eagles 2003-04 opponents are any indication of future performance, AU should have a successful season. The Eagles have a combined 102-51 (.667) record against the opponents on this season's schedule, and have a winning record when playing 13 of their 16 opponents which they have previously played. The Eagles records against 2003-04 opponents are as follows: Army, 4-3; Brown, 5-4; Bucknell, 6-3; Colgate, 5-1; Elon, 0-1; Holy Cross, 0-5; Howard, 8-6; Lafayette, 10-0; Lehigh, 7-2; Liberty, 4-0; Loyola (Md.), 6-2; UMBC, 5-3; UMES, 8-1; Mt. St. Mary's, 4-5; Navy, 10-7; and William & Mary, 26-11.

## SLUMPING

The Eagles have lost their last four games, due in large part to decreased scoring. Prior to the four-game losing streak, American was scoring 63.4 points per game on 42.5 percent shooting and went 5-2. In the four most recent losses, AU has scored just 53.8 points per game and shot 32.4 percent. The Eagles have also been outrebounded by their last four opponents, with American grabbing 36.8 rebounds per game compared with its opponents 38.8 rebounds per game during the losing streak. That could largely be due to the individual matchups the Eagles have encountered in those games, having to face William & Mary's 6-3 center, Maria Sazanova, Elon's 6-5 center Courtney Nyborg, Brown's 6-5 center Holly Robertson and Kent State's twin towers of 6-6 center Andrea Csaszar and 6-2 forward Lindsay Shearer. The task gets no easier for the Eagles tonight, with Liberty featuring 6-8 center Katie Feenstra.
