LAST TIME OUT

Kaitlin Schuyler gathered in a pass from Chanel Hunt and drove to the basket, sinking a layup with just two seconds left to lift American to a 50-49 victory over Bucknell Saturday in Bender Arena in the Patriot League opener for both schools.

The Eagles held a slim advantage throughout most of the second half, however, their biggest lead in the final stanza was only five points (38-33). That occurred when Joanna Barnes hit a layup with 9:43 remaining. Barnes, who had scored a career-high 23 points in her previous outing versus Liberty, finished with six points and four rebounds in 26 minutes of action. Bucknell took a one-point lead with 1:23 remaining on a pair of free throws by Lillian Drumgold. Both teams then went scoreless until Schuyler's winning bucket.

Schuyler finished with 10 points, five rebounds and three assists in 35 minutes of action. Hunt grabbed five rebounds, scored four points and dished out two assists in 38 minutes. In the first half Bucknell got off to a fast start, eventually building an eight-point lead (24-16) at 8:11. The Bison still held an eight-point edge with 4:04 left when the Eagles made their move. They scored the next 11 points to take a 29-26 lead. Bucknell answered with a bucket with three seconds left in the first stanza to pull the Bison to within one at the half.

Schuyler started the run with a pair of threes. Kim Salem grabbed an offensive rebound and put it back in for another two points, tying the game at 26 apiece. Finally, Angel Jordan finished the Eagles streak with a three-pointer with 19 seconds left in the opening period.

Chanel Spriggs chipped in four points, two assists and grabbed a game-high four steals. Salem led AU in rebounding with eight while scoring nine points. Jordan led the Eagles in scoring for the first time this year with 13 points on five-of-eight shooting. She was three-of-three from beyond the arc and she accomplished all this in just 11 minutes of action.

American shot 32.8 percent from the field while Bucknell hit on 37.5 percent of its shots, making it the only time this year AU has been able to win after shooting a lower percentage than its opponent.

Bucknell's Hollobaugh led all scorers with 17 points, while the Eagles held Desire Almind, the Bison's leading scorer at 19.1 points per game entering today's contest, to just eight points, all in the first half. Almind added 15 rebounds.

THE OPPONENT AND THE HISTORY

This is the 18th meeting between American University and the Midshipmen of Navy. In the two seasons in which the Eagles have played in the Patriot League, Navy has split both season series with AU. In the teams' last meeting, Navy pulled out a 75-72 overtime thriller. The Mids enter this evening's game on a three-game losing streak, including dropping their Patriot League opener to Lehigh on Jan. 10, 71-61.

ON THIS DATE

The Eagles defeated Norfolk State on Feb. 13, 1989, 98-91 in double overtime. At the time, the 189 combined points were the most in AU history. The 1999-00 squad bested that record in a 115-93 loss to Richmond on Jan. 28, 2000.

UP NEXT

American continues its Patriot League docket with a home contest against Lehigh on Saturday, Jan. 17, 2004. The Eagles will also celebrate National Girls and Women in Sports Day, with prizes, giveaways and an autograph session following the contest.

SPRIGGS RANKED SECOND IN NCAA IN STEALS/GAME

As of Jan. 5, senior guard Chanel Spriggs ranked second in the National Collegiate Athletic Association's Division I in steals per game with 4.0 steals in each game which she has played. At the time of the rankings, Spriggs had nabbed 44 steals in 11 games. She was just 0.1 away from the nation's leader, April Banks of Wichita State, who had 37 steals in nine games. Spriggs, who is known for her thievery, set AU's career steals record earlier this season when she pilfered six balls from UMBC. She currently has 267 steals and continues to stretch her lead in that category every game.

KEY STAT: SHOOTING PERCENTAGE

Four of American's six wins this season have come when the Eagles shoot .400 or better. In each of AU's seven losses, the Eagles have had a sub-.400 shooting night. The Eagles are currently shooting .372 as a team on the season. AU is also undefeated (5-0) when they shoot better from the field than its opponent. Against Bucknell on Jan. 10, the Eagles captured their first victory when shooting a lower percentage than their opponent. Still, AU is just 1-7 when its shooting percentage is lower than the team it is facing.

CHASING 1,000

After 13 games this season, junior forward **Chanel Hunt** has 779 career points (11.3 ppg), including 417 points last season (14.4 ppg). Hunt needs to average 15.8 ppg over the 14 remaining regular season games to reach the 221 points needed to attain 1,000 career points. Hunt is averaging 10.0 ppg so far this season. If Hunt can attain her 14.4 ppg scoring average from last season, she will score her 1,000th point on Feb. 20, 2004, at home against Holy Cross. Hunt would be just the 11th Eagle in school history to reach four-digits in scoring. Felicia Young is the school's all-time leading scorer, with 1,708 points.

Meanwhile, Senior guard **Chanel Spriggs** is also chasing down the 1,000-point barrier, albeit in a less traditional way. The 5-7 Sunderland, Md., native played her freshman season (1999-2000) at NCAA Division III St. Mary's College of Maryland. She scored 229 points that season (8.5 ppg), and has scored 724 points in her three seasons at American, giving her 953 career points. At Spriggs' current pace (she is averaging 10.5 ppg this season), she will reach 1,000 points at Holy Cross on Jan. 25.

#10 FOR 10 OR MORE IN 10 STRAIGHT

Senior guard **Kaitlin Schuyler** has scored in double digits in 10 consecutive games. During that streak, the 5-7 Baltimore native has taken over as the Eagles' leading scorer, averaging 10.8 points per game. In addition, Schuyler has been AU's point guard for much of the season and is the only player on the squad with a positive assist-to-turnover ratio. Schuyler has dished out 47 dimes and given the ball away only 45 times.

Scouting Report

Navy: The streaky Midshipmen enter this evening's contest on a three-game losing streak. However, Navy has not lost more than three consecutive games nor won more than two in a row yet this season.

The Mids are led on the offensive half by 5-10 senior guard **Courtney Davidson**, who averages 18.6 ppg and is shooting 37 percent from behind the arc. Davidson has led Navy in scoring in 10 of its 15 games, including the last five. Forward **Adrienne Rosetti** is second on the team in scoring, at 12.1 ppg, and leads the Mids in rebounding, snagging 6.4 caroms per contest. Point guard **Maile Shimoda** distributes the ball, dishing out 86 assists so far this season (5.7 apg). **Abi Campbell** has provided another outside threat for Navy, connecting on 36 percent of her attempts from three-point land.

Several players on the 2003-04 Eagles have either already broken records or have a chance to make their marks on the AU career record books. Here is a list of those players and their superlatives:

Chanel Hunt	<i>Points</i>	Has 779 points, with a chance to become just the 11th Eagle to surpass the 1,000-point barrier this season.
	<i>Rebounds</i>	Has 459 career rebounds, with a chance to break into the school's top-10. If Hunt repeats her 212 rebound performance from last season, she will finish her junior season ranked seventh in career rebounds with 582, and would have a chance of breaking the school record of 881 career rebounds, set by Mary Klima from 1994 to 1998.
	<i>Shooting Pct.</i>	Currently shooting .465 for her career, which would place her ninth on the school's all-time list. Recently cracked into the school's all-time top-10 in steals, with 176. If Hunt replicates her 83-steal effort from last season, she will move into second all-time at AU in steals.
	<i>Steals</i>	
Kaitlin Schuyler	<i>Three-pointers Made</i>	Currently ranks second in career three-points, with 117. She has an outside shot of breaking the school record of 147, set by Kari Gaskins from 1995 to 1999. She would need to average more than two three-pointers per game for the rest of the season. In the 2003-04 season, Schuyler is averaging 1.92 three-pointers per game.
	<i>3-pt. Shooting Pct.</i>	Currently ranks 10th, hitting .287 of her attempts.

SCORING ANGELS

The Eagles' two Angels, **Angel Jordan** and **Angel McNatt**, have shown a propensity to score in bunches when called upon by head coach **Shann Hart** to provide a spark. Although McNatt is averaging just 8.2 min. per game and Jordan 6.8, if you were to prorate their offensive output to 40 min. per game, McNatt would be averaging 20.4 ppg and Jordan would be averaging 23.2 ppg. A fine example of this is the 50-49 win over Bucknell, when Jordan came in for just 11 minutes but tallied 13 points.
