Lehigh is coached by **Sue Troyan** (Dickinson '88), who is in her eighth season with the Mountain Hawks. Troyan owns a career record of 113-127 (.471), all at Lehigh. Troyan is assisted by **Jim Sexton**, **Tempie Brown**, and **Dorothy Super**.

LAST TIME OUT

Despite shooting just 15.6 percent in the opening stanza and 25.4 percent for the game Tuesday night against Navy, the Eagles' stifling defense held the Midshipmen to just 29.5 percent shooting on the night and forced 24 turnovers in a 51-42 victory.

The Eagles hit just five of their 32 shots in the opening period and trailed at halftime, 16-13. After Navy hit a bucket to open the second stanza and take a five-point lead, American responded with a 9-0 run to go ahead, 22-16.

Still, Navy fought back to tie the score at 26 on a jumper by Adrienne Rosetti with just over 11 minutes remaining in the contest. It was then that American's defense took over the game. The Eagles did not allow a Navy field goal for more than nine minutes. The Midshipmen's only points in that streak came via the free throw line.

Trailing 44-40 with 1:33 remaining, the Midshipmen began fouling. However, AU came through on the free throw line, hitting five-of-six in the next 29 seconds to take a nine-point lead, 49-40, to seal the win.

The 42 points scored by Navy are the fifth fewest points allowed by the Eagles since the 1978-79 season. In addition, American committed a season-low six turnovers.

American also held Navy's Courtney Davidson, the Patriot League's leading scorer coming into the contest at 18.6 ppg, to just seven points on two-for-10 shooting. Davidson also committed four turnovers in the face of the Eagles' intense defensive pressure. It is the second straight game in which AU shut down the opponent's top scorer, after the Eagles allowed just eight points — all in the first half — by Bucknell's Desire Almind, the league's second-leading scorer at 18.3 ppg, in a 50-49 win over the Bison on Jan. 10.

Senior guard **Kaitlin Schuyler** led the Eagles with 11 points, five assists, five rebounds and four steals. Tonight was the 11th consecutive game in which Schuyler scored in double digits. Meanwhile, **Kim Salem** scored 10 points and ripped down five boards.

THE OPPONENT AND THE HISTORY

This is the 10th meeting between American University and the Mountain Hawks of Lehigh. The Eagles have taken three of four contests from Lehigh since AU joined the Patriot League, including sweeping the season series last year. However, both contests last season were decided by single digits, with the Eagles capturing a 71-67 victory in Bethlehem, Pa., and a 53-47 win in Bender Arena. Although the Mountain Hawks lost eight of their first nine games of the season, they have rebound mightily, winning four of their last five. In addition, Lehigh has won both its Patriot League contests, against Navy, 71-61, and Bucknell, 69-58.

ON THIS DATE

The Eagles defeated then Colonial Athletic Association foe Navy on Jan. 17, 1986, 79-70. The win was one of 20 in that season, the Eagles' first-ever 20-win season. However, the 1985-86 season ended in heartbreaking fashion, with a one-point loss to East Carolina in the first round of the CAA tournament.

UP NEXT

American hits the pavement for its longest Patriot League trip of the year, heading to upstate New York to face Colgate on Friday, Jan. 23, for a 5:30 p.m. start. From there, the Eagles will travel east to Worcester, Mass., to square off against perennial Patriot League favorite Holy Cross on Sunday, Jan. 25, beginning at noon.

SPRIGGS NO. 1 IN NCAA IN STEALS PER GAME

As of Jan. 12, senior guard **Chanel Spriggs** is ranked first in the National Collegiate Athletic Association's Division I in steals per game with 4.2 steals in each game which she has played. Spriggs has currently nabbed 55 steals in 14 games (3.9 ppg). Spriggs, who is known for her thievery, set AU's career steals record earlier this season when she pilfered six balls from UMBC. She currently has 272 steals and continues to stretch her lead in that category every game.

CHASING 1,000

After 14 games this season, junior forward **Chanel Hunt** has 787 career points (11.2 ppg), including 417 points last season (14.4 ppg). Hunt needs to average 16.4 ppg over the 13 remaining regular season games to reach the 213 points needed to attain 1,000 career points. Hunt is averaging 9.9 ppg so far this season. If Hunt can attain her 14.4 ppg scoring average from last season, she will score her 1,000th point on Feb. 20, 2004, at home against Holy Cross. Hunt would be just the 11th Eagle in school history to reach four-digits in scoring. Felicia Young is the school's all-time leading scorer, with 1,708 points.

Meanwhile, Senior guard **Chanel Spriggs** is also chasing down the 1,000-point barrier, albeit in a less traditional way. The 5-7 Sunderland, Md., native played her freshman season (1999-2000) at NCAA Division III St. Mary's College of Maryland. She scored 229 points that season (8.5 ppg), and has scored 731 points in her three seasons at American, giving her 960 career points. At Spriggs' current pace (she is averaging 10.5 ppg this season), she will reach 1,000 points at Holy Cross on Jan. 25.

#10 FOR 10 OR MORE IN 11 STRAIGHT

Senior guard **Kaitlin Schuyler** has scored in double digits in 11 consecutive games. During that streak, the 5-7 Baltimore native has taken over as the Eagles' leading scorer, averaging 10.9 points per game. In addition, Schuyler has been AU's point guard for much of the season and is the only player on the squad with a positive assist-to-turnover ratio. Schuyler has dished out 52 dimes and given the ball away only 46 times.

DEFENSE ... DEFENSE ... DEFENSE ...

A hallmark of the AU squads under coach **Shann Hart's** tenure has been defense, and plenty of it. The 2003-04 Eagles are no different. This year's version of the team ranks 12th in NCAA Division I in steals per game (12.1/game) and is holding its opponents to just 58.3 points per game. The Eagles have stepped up their defense in their first two Patriot League games, holding Bucknell -- which came in averaging 65.0 points per game -- to just 49, and Navy -- which came in averaging 63.1 points per game -- to just 42.

In addition, AU has shown its ability to shut down individual scorers. In their last game, the Eagles held Navy's Courtney Davidson, the Patriot League's leading scorer coming into the contest at 18.6 ppg, to just seven points on two-for-10 shooting. Against Bucknell, the Eagles allowed just eight points -- all in the first half -- by the Bison's Desire Almind, the league's second-leading scorer at 18.3 ppg, in a 50-49 win.

Scouting Report

Lehigh: The Mountain Hawks' season appeared to be a bust nine games in, having lost eight of those contests. However, Lehigh has rebounded in a big way, winning four of its last five, including its first two Patriot League games.

The Mountain Hawks are led offensively by junior center **Jessica DePalo**, who averages 16.4 points per game and is the only Lehigh player averaging double figures in points and the only player to have started every game. DePalo has taken more than double the number of shots than any other player on the squad. **Jana Ransomis** second on the squad in scoring, with 8.3 ppg. Guard **Teniece Johnson** has 35 assists.

Head coach **Sue Troyan** has employed 10 different players to make up her starting five so far this season. In addition, nine players average more than 12 minutes per game.

DISHING THE ROCK

Senior guard **Kaitlin Schuyler** has 275 assists in her three-plus seasons at AU. She recently took over sixth place on the school's all-time assist list. Schuyler passed out a career-high 83 assists (3.5 apg) in the 2001-02 season, and followed that up with 75 assists in 29 games (2.6 apg) last year. In her freshman campaign, Schuyler dished out 65 assists in 23 games (2.8 apg). For her career, Schuyler has given out 3.0 assists per game. If she continues on that pace, Schuyler has a chance to move into fourth place on the school's all-time career assists list, behind Danielle Blackburn (340), Karen Jenkins (396) and the school's all-time leader, Jody Thornton, who had 693 assists between 1983 and 1987. Schuyler leads the 2003-04 Eagles with 44 assists, including tallying seven dimes versus Mount St. Mary's.

CONSECUTIVE GAMES STARTED

Chanel Spriggs is currently ranked 11th in NCAA Division I in consecutive games started by an active player, having been in the starting lineup in 69 consecutive games. Duke's Alana Beard leads the way, starting an astounding 116 consecutive games (*Information compiled by West Virginia University Assistant Sports Information Director Phil Caskey*).

WHO'S NEXT?

Six different AU players have led the team in scoring in the Eagles' 14 games thus far. Chanel Spriggs leads the way, scoring the most points in a game five times this season. Chanel Hunt has led the team in scoring three times, while Kaitlin Schuyler and Angel Jordan have each led the team in scoring twice. Joanna Barnes and Angel McNatt have taken home team-high scoring honors once each.

UPSIDE DOWN

Against Navy on Tuesday, American set season lows in field goals made, field goal percentage, three-point field goals made, three-point field goal percentage and assists, and yet won the game, 51-42. However, in the Eagles' loss to Liberty, AU set season highs in field goal attempts, three-point field goals made, three-point field goal attempts, free throws made, rebounds, blocked shots and fouls, but lost in double-overtime, 76-72.

CLIMBING THE CHARTS FROM OUTSIDE THE ARC

Senior guard **Kaitlin Schuyler** is currently ranked second in school history in career three-pointers made and career three-pointers attempted. She is 29 three-pointers away from the school record for treys made -- 147, by Kari Gaskins -- and has an outside shot to break the record. With 13 regular season games remaining, and at least one Patriot League Tournament game, Schuyler would have to average just over two three-pointers per game to topple the old record. She has hit 26 treys so far this season, or 1.86 per game. Schuyler will likely break the school record for most three-pointers taken, which is 434 by Gaskins. The 5-7 Schuyler needs to fire up just 17 more treys to break that record. Schuyler is currently averaging 2.7 three-point attempts per game, and is on pace to break the record on Feb. 4 at the University of Maryland-Eastern Shore.
