## LAST TIME OUT

Kim Salem scored a career-high 17 points and Chanel Hunt posted her third double-double of the season, but it was not enough as the Eagles lost to Patriot League foe Lehigh by 14, 69-55.

The Mountain Hawks got out of the gate very fast on offense as they shot 70.0 percent from beyond the three-point line (7-of-10) and 57.5 overall (15-of-26) in the first half. Sara Ellis hit four-of-five threes in the first stanza, and finished with a game-high 19 points. Despite the torrid shooting by Lehigh the Eagles managed to stay within 10 points for most of the first half. Unfortunately, Lehigh went on a 10-3 run to close out the first half up 16 points, 38-22.

The teams traded baskets for the first eight minutes of the second half when AU began to make a run. Trailing 49-31 the Eagles went on a 14-2 run over a four-minute span. Salem started things off with a pair of free throws, and Joanna Barnes followed with two more. Salem then collected a pass from Courtney Spellacy and hit a layup. Salem then hit another free throw after she was fouled. A steal by Kaitlin Schuyler led to a layup by Chanel Spriggs. Salem then hit another layup, and Angel Jordan finished the run with a three-pointer. Salem scored seven of the 14 points.

Unfortunately, American could not get any closer than six points (56-50) with 5:13 remaining. Lehigh closed the game out strong, eventually winning by 14. Salem led AU with 17 points and was six-of-nine from the floor. Hunt had 10 points and 10 rebounds, two assists, two steals and one block, while Spriggs finished with 13 points and five rebounds. American shot 35.6 percent from the field for the game and was outrebounded by seven (36-29). They did force Lehigh into 22 turnovers and collected 11 steals.

## THE OPPONENT AND THE HISTORY

This is the seventh meeting between American University and the Raiders of Colgate University. The Eagles hold a 5-1 series advantage over CU, with AU's only loss coming in the 2002 Patriot League Tournament. Although the Eagles are undefeated at both Bender Arena and Cotterell Court versus Colgate, none of the wins have come easy. Each of the Eagles five victories in the series have come by single digits. Colgate enters today's contest fresh off a 79-76 loss to league foe Army. Prior to that, the Raiders knocked off Lafayette in Easton, Pa., and perennial league favorite Holy Cross.

## ON THIS DATE

The Eagles defeated local rival Marymount 78-17 on Jan. 23, 1975. The 61-point margin of victory was the third largest in school history, behind a 65-point blowout of Immaculata in 1975 and a 63-point win over Immaculata in the 1975-76 season. The win was part of an 11-4 season, which set a school record for most wins in a season. That record has since been surpassed several times. The record is now 23 wins, set by the 1997-98 squad, who finished 23-7 and made the school's only appearance in a postseason tournament. That team lost in the first round of the Women's National Invitation Tournament to St. Joseph's, 77-68.

## UP NEXT

American heads East to square off against perennial league power Holy Cross on Sunday, Jan. 25 at 3 p.m. The Eagles then host Lafayette and Army on Friday, Jan. 30 and Sun., Feb. 1.

## SPRIGGS NO. 3 IN NCAA IN STEALS PER GAME

As of Jan. 19, senior guard **Chanel Spriggs** is ranked third in the National Collegiate Athletic Association's Division I in steals per game with 3.9 steals in each game which she has played. Spriggs has currently nabbed 55 steals in 14 games (3.9 ppg). The 5-7 Sunderland, Md., native was leading the nation in steals, at 4.2 per game, in the last NCAA statistical ranking period. Spriggs, who is known for her thievery, set AU's career steals record earlier this season when she pilfered six balls from UMBC. She currently has 272 steals and continues to stretch her lead in that category every game.

## CHASING 1,000

Junior forward **Chanel Hunt** currently has 797 career points (11.2 ppg), including 417 points last season (14.4 ppg). Hunt needs to average 16.9 ppg over the 13 remaining regular season games to reach the 213 points needed to attain 1,000 career points. Hunt is averaging 9.9 ppg so far this season. If Hunt can attain her 14.4 ppg scoring average from last season, she will score her 1,000th point on Feb. 20, 2004, at home against Holy Cross. Hunt would be just the 11th Eagle in school history to reach four-digits in scoring. Felicia Young is the school's all-time leading scorer, with 1,708 points.

Meanwhile, Senior guard **Chanel Spriggs** is also chasing down the 1,000-point barrier, albeit in a less traditional way. The 5-7 Sunderland, Md., native played her freshman season (1999-2000) at NCAA Division III St. Mary's College of Maryland. She scored 229 points that season (8.5 ppg), and has scored 744 points in her three seasons at American, giving her 973 career points. At Spriggs' current pace (she is averaging 10.4 ppg this season), she will reach 1,000 points against Lafayette at home on Jan. 30.

## DEFENSE ... DEFENSE ... DEFENSE ...

A hallmark of the AU squads under coach **Shann Hart**'s tenure has been defense, and plenty of it. The 2003-04 Eagles are no different. This year's version of the team ranks 12th in NCAA Division I in steals per game (12.1/game) and is holding its opponents to just 59.0 points per game. If the Eagles can maintain that average, they would go down as arguably the best defensive squad in school history. The 2002-03 Eagles set a school record for least points per game allowed, at 64.6, and the 2003-04 AU squad could surpass that.

## Scouting Report

**Colgate:** The high-scoring Raiders tally 73.3 points per game as a team, but allow nearly 69 per game. In addition, opponents are outshooting Colgate 43 percent to 42.3 percent.

The Raiders feature a trio of players adept at filling up the basket. Leading the way is **Emily Braseth**, who tips the scales at 17.6 ppg and also leads the team in rebounding, with 7.4 per game. Braseth is a sharpshooter, hitting nearly 52 percent of her field goal attempts and 41.7 percent of her attempts outside the arc. Veteran forward **Malissa Burke** chips in 13.1 ppg and 2.7 boards per contest. In addition, freshman phenom **Molly Patterson** scores 11.5 ppg and adds 5.1 rpg.

Colgate boasts a trio of gunners from the outside. Burke, Patterson and **Meghan Curtin** have all hit more than 20 treys and are all shooting better than 32 percent from downtown.

## DISHING THE ROCK

Senior guard **Kaitlin Schuyler** has 279 assists in her three-plus seasons at AU. She recently took over fifth place on the school's all-time assist list. Schuyler passed out a career-high 83 assists (3.5 apg) in the 2001-02 season, and followed that up with 75 assists in 29 games (2.6 apg) last year. In her freshman campaign, Schuyler dished out 65 assists in 23 games (2.8 apg). For her career, Schuyler has given out 3.0 assists per game. If she continues on that pace, Schuyler has a chance to move into fourth place on the school's all-time career assists list, behind Danielle Blackburn (340), Karen Jenkins (396) and the school's all-time leader, Jody Thornton, who had 693 assists between 1983 and 1987. Schuyler leads the 2003-04 Eagles with 56 assists, including tallying seven dimes versus Mount St. Mary's.

## CONSECUTIVE GAMES STARTED

Chanel Spriggs is currently ranked 11th in NCAA Division I in consecutive games started by an active player, having been in the starting lineup in 70 consecutive games. Duke's Alana Beard leads the way, starting an astounding 116 consecutive games (*Information compiled by West Virginia University Assistant Sports Information Director Phil Caskey*).

## WHO'S NEXT?

Seven different AU players have led the team in scoring in the Eagles' 15 games thus far. **Chanel Spriggs** leads the way, scoring the most points in a game five times this season. **Chanel Hunt** has led the team in scoring three times, while **Kaitlin Schuyler** and **Angel Jordan** have each led the team in scoring twice. **Joanna Barnes**, **Angel McNatt** and **Kim Salem** have taken home team-high scoring honors once each.

## KEY STAT

The Eagles are 6-1 when leading at halftime, but just 1-7 when trailing at the intermission. The only game in which AU trailed at the half and came back to win was against Navy, when the Eagles shot just 15 percent in the first stanza and scored only 13 first-half points. However, American responded with a 38-point second half in a 51-42 win. AU's lone loss when leading at the half was against Brown on Jan. 2, when the Eagles held a 26-21 halftime lead but allowed the Bears to score 40 second-half points and win, 61-52.

## OFFENSE VS. DEFENSE

Tonight's matchup will feature an intriguing battle between the Patriot League's number one offense -- Colgate, which averages 73.3 ppg -- versus the league's best defense -- American, which allows just 59.1 ppg. The pace of the game could be a key factor in determining who comes out victorious. In six of the Eagles' seven victories thus far, they have held their opponent to below 60 points. However, seven of AU's eight losses have come when it allowed more than 61 points. Conversely, seven of Colgate's nine wins have come when it has scored at least 74 points.

## HITTING HER SHOTS

Junior forward **Kim Salem** is shooting .538 (42-of-78) this season. The 6-1 Canadian has been especially hot lately, hitting 13 of her last 19 shots (.684), over the last three games. Salem is coming off her best effort of the season, where she hit six-of-nine shots and scored a career-high 17 points. She would be in third place in the Patriot League in field goal percentage, but has not hit the required average of three field goals per game to qualify.

## EAGLES WELCOME TRANSFER

Sophomore forward **Abby Lipskis** has joined American after transferring from the University of Rhode Island. The 6-2 Lipskis, who played her prep ball in Norfolk, Va. for Norfolk Collegiate, played in 18 games as a freshman, starting three, and averaged 1.4 ppg and 1.9 rpg. Due to NCAA transfer rules, Lipskis will not be eligible to play for AU until mid-way through the 2004-05 season. However, Lipskis has been practicing with the team and could figure to be a post presence in the Patriot League come 2005.
