Hart has a career record of 119-89 [.572]. Hart led American to 18 wins last season, the most since the 1997-98 season. She is assisted by **Glenn Rigney** (Miami '79), **Deb Reardon** (Assumption '86), **Brian Johnson** (Drexel '98) and graduate manager **Quintina Walker** (William & Mary '02).

Holy Cross is coached by **Bill Gibbons** (Clark, '81), who is in his 19th season with the Crusaders. Gibbons owns a career record of 387-167 (.699), all at Holy Cross. Gibbons is assisted by **Catherine DiGiacinto**, **Anne Kinne** and **Brian Wilson**.

# AMERICAN UNIVERSITY WOMEN'S BASKETBALL



## LAST TIME OUT

American University's **Chanel Hunt** hit a fallaway jumper from the right baseline with 0.5 seconds left in a 58-57 victory over host Colgate Friday night at Cotterell Court in Hamilton, N.Y.

Colgate, clinging to a 57-56 lead with 12 seconds remaining, had a chance to seal a win when Meghan Curtin headed the line for two shots. However, the 6-1 sophomore guard missed both of her tries and **Joanna Barnes** corralled the loose-ball rebound. Hunt drove it the length of the floor, and the Eagles called timeout, setting up the final shot.

Hunt was the answer for the Eagles all game, hitting nine of her 18 shots and scoring a season-high 24 points. She also ripped down seven boards and hit six-of-eight free throws. With the score tied at 10 at the 14:40 mark of the first stanza, Colgate raced out to a 14-point lead with a 16-2 run over the next six minutes. But American rebounded and pulled within nine at the half.

In the second stanza, AU slowly whittled the Raiders' lead down to one several times, but could not get over the hump until the 1:34 mark of the second period. It was the Eagles' first lead since three minutes into the game.

Both teams traded the lead, with Hunt and Colgate's Emily Braseth trading buckets, until Hunt hit her last shot to win the game.

For the Eagles, who improve to 8-8 and 3-1 in the Patriot League, **Kim Salem** had 11 points and five rebounds.

Braseth led the Raiders with 16 points and nine rebounds. Colgate falls to 9-7 on the season and 2-2 in the Patriot League.

## THE OPPONENT AND THE HISTORY

This is the sixth meeting between American University and the Crusaders of Holy Cross. Holy Cross holds a 5-0 advantage in the series. The closest the Eagles came to a victory in the series was a 84-78 overtime loss on Jan. 26, 2003. However, Holy Cross -- the perennial Patriot League favorite -- enters today's contest struggling. The Crusaders are 7-10, 2-2 in the Patriot League, and have lost six of their last nine games.

## ON THIS DATE

The Eagles defeated former Colonial Athletic Association foe Richmond on Jan. 25, 1985, 77-67. The win was one of 20 that season, the first ever 20-win season in school history. The 1985-86 season ended in heartbreaking fashion, a 69-68 loss to East Carolina on March 1, 1986, in the second round of the CAA Tournament.

## UP NEXT

American hosts the winless Lafayette Leopards on Jan. 30. Game time is set for 5:30 p.m. AU will be celebrating Hall of Fame weekend, as it inducts track greats Dave Reinhart and Gary Cohen and men's basketball legend Brian Gilgeous. The weekend wraps up when the Eagles host Army on Sunday, Feb. 1, beginning at 3 p.m.

## SPRIGGS NO. 3 IN NCAA IN STEALS PER GAME

As of Jan. 19, senior guard **Chanel Spriggs** is ranked third in the National Collegiate Athletic Association's Division I in steals per game with 3.9 steals in each game which she has played. Spriggs has currently nabbed 55 steals in 14 games (3.9 ppg). The 5-7 Sunderland, Md., native was leading the nation in steals, at 4.2 per game, in the last NCAA statistical ranking period. Spriggs, who is known for her thievery, set AU's career steals record earlier this season when she pilfered six balls from UMBC. She currently has 272 steals and continues to stretch her lead in that category every game.

## CHASING 1,000

Junior forward **Chanel Hunt** currently has 821 career points, including 417 points last season (14.4 ppg). Hunt needs to average 14.9 ppg over the 12 remaining regular season games to reach the 179 points needed to attain 1,000 career points. Hunt is averaging 10.8 ppg so far this season. If Hunt can attain her 14.4 ppg scoring average from last season, she will score her 1,000th point on Feb. 20, 2004, at home against Holy Cross. Hunt would be just the 11th Eagle in school history to reach four-digits in scoring. Felicia Young is the school's all-time leading scorer, with 1,708 points.

Meanwhile, Senior guard **Chanel Spriggs** is also chasing down the 1,000-point barrier, albeit in a less traditional way. The 5-7 Sunderland, Md., native played her freshman season (1999-2000) at NCAA Division III St. Mary's College of Maryland. She scored 229 points that season (8.5 ppg), and has scored 751 points in her three seasons at American, giving her 980 career points. At Spriggs' current pace (she is averaging 10.2 ppg this season), she will reach 1,000 points against Lafayette at home on Jan. 30.

## DEFENSE ... DEFENSE ... DEFENSE ...

A hallmark of the AU squads under coach **Shann Hart**'s tenure has been defense, and plenty of it. The 2003-04 Eagles are no different. This year's version of the team ranks 12th in NCAA Division I in steals per game (12.1/game) and is holding its opponents to just 59.0 points per game. If the Eagles can maintain that average, they would go down as arguably the best defensive squad in school history. The 2002-03 Eagles set a school record for least points per game allowed, at 64.6, and the 2003-04 AU squad could surpass that.

## Scouting Report

**Holy Cross:** The Crusaders are led by the two-headed monster of **Maggie Fontana** and **Lisa Andrews**. Both players average more than 14 ppg and five rebounds per contest. Fontana, a 5-11 guard, creates matchup problems with her size. Andrews, a 6-3 center, is a dominating force in the paint, avering 6.2 rpg and blocking more than 40 shots. Sophomore guard **Sarah Placek**, who grew up near American University in Alexandria, Va., represents half of the Crusaders' outside threat, hitting three at about a 35 percent pace. In addition, another sophomore -- **Jessica Conte** -- is firing up treys at about 32 percent.

The Crusaders may have a losing record, but their schedule is nothing to ridicule. Holy Cross has squared off against five Big East squads, including Connecticut, as well as Arizona State and Wake Forest.

## DISHING THE ROCK

Senior guard **Kaitlin Schuyler** has 282 assists in her three-plus seasons at AU. She recently took over fifth place on the school's all-time assist list. Schuyler passed out a career-high 83 assists (3.5 apg) in the 2001-02 season, and followed that up with 75 assists in 29 games (2.6 apg) last year. In her freshman campaign, Schuyler dished out 65 assists in 23 games (2.8 apg). For her career, Schuyler has given out 3.0 assists per game. If she continues on that pace, Schuyler has a chance to move into fourth place on the school's all-time career assists list, behind Danielle Blackburn (340), Karen Jenkins (396) and the school's all-time leader, Jody Thornton, who had 693 assists between 1983 and 1987. Schuyler leads the 2003-04 Eagles with 59 assists, including tallying seven dimes versus Mount St. Mary's.

## CONSECUTIVE GAMES STARTED

Chanel Spriggs is currently ranked 11th in NCAA Division I in consecutive games started by an active player, having been in the starting lineup in 71 consecutive games. Duke's Alana Beard leads the way, starting an astounding 116 consecutive games (*Information compiled by West Virginia University Assistant Sports Information Director Phil Caskey*).

## WHO'S NEXT?

Seven different AU players have led the team in scoring in the Eagles' 15 games thus far. **Chanel Spriggs** leads the way, scoring the most points in a game five times this season. **Chanel Hunt** has led the team in scoring four times, while **Kaitlin Schuyler** and **Angel Jordan** have each led the team in scoring twice. **Joanna Barnes**, **Angel McNatt** and **Kim Salem** have taken home team-high scoring honors once each.

## KEY STAT

The Eagles are 6-1 when leading at halftime, but just 2-7 when trailing at the intermission. The only games in which AU trailed at the half and came back to win were against Navy, when the Eagles shot just 15 percent in the first stanza and scored only 13 first-half points, and against Colgate. AU's lone loss when leading at the half was against Brown on Jan. 2, when the Eagles held a 26-21 halftime lead but allowed the Bears to score 40 second-half points and win, 61-52.

## HITTING HER SHOTS

Junior forward **Kim Salem** is shooting .538 (42-of-78) this season. The 6-1 Canadian has been especially hot lately, hitting 17 of her last 26 shots (.654), over the last three games. Salem is coming off her best effort of the season, where she hit six-of-nine shots and scored a career-high 17 points. She would be in third place in the Patriot League in field goal percentage, but has not hit the required average of three field goals per game to qualify.

## EAGLES WELCOME TRANSFER

Sophomore forward **Abby Lipskis** has joined American after transferring from the University of Rhode Island. The 6-2 Lipskis, who played her prep ball in Norfolk, Va. for Norfolk Collegiate, played in 18 games as a freshman, starting three, and averaged 1.4 ppg and 1.9 rpg. Due to NCAA transfer rules, Lipskis will not be eligible to play for AU until mid-way through the 2004-05 season. However, Lipskis has been practicing with the team and could figure to be a post presence in the Patriot League come 2005.
