**The Coaches**

American University is coached by **Shann Hart** (Norfolk State '88), who is in her fourth season leading the Eagles, and seventh overall as a collegiate head coach. Hart has a career record of 119-90 [.569]. Hart led American to 18 wins last season, the most since the 1997-98 season. She is assisted by **Glenn Rigney** (Miami '79), **Deb Reardon** (Assumption '86), **Brian Johnson** (Drexel '98) and graduate manager **Quintina Walker** (William & Mary '02).

Lafayette is coached by **Tammy Smith** (East Stroudsburg '82), who is in her fourth season with the Leopards. Smith owns a career record of 119-135 (.469), including a 6-67 (.082) record at Lafayette. Smith is assisted by **LaRonda Murphy**, **Shelby Kealy** and **Ron Hoffman**.

## LAST TIME OUT

American University women's basketball shot just 28 percent and allowed host Holy Cross to shoot nearly 49 percent in a 74-56 loss Sunday in the Hart Center.

With the game tied at eight a piece at the 15:33 mark of the first period, a three-pointer by Holy Cross' Maggie Fontana launched a 17-4 run that gave the hosts a 25-12 lead with 7:33 left in the stanza. Overall, Holy Cross outscored the Eagles 29-13 in the last 15 minutes of the first half, and the Crusaders held a 16-point advantage at halftime.

The Crusaders built up their sizable halftime lead on the strength of 59 percent shooting in the opening period, including hitting three-of-seven three-point attempts. AU hit just nine-of-33 field goals in the first period.

In the second half, Holy Cross extended its lead to as much as 24, and AU could get no closer than 15 in the latter period. The Crusaders maintained their lead down the stretch by scoring 16 of their final 20 points from the line. The two teams combined for 47 fouls, and two players for AU fouled out.

**Joanna Barnes** led the Eagles with 14 points, including hitting six-of-eight from the line. **Kaitlin Schuyler** chipped in 10 points, and **Chanel Hunt** added 10 boards.

Freshman **Brittany Kiel** scored a career-high 15 points to lead all scorers.

## THE OPPONENT AND THE HISTORY

This is the 11th meeting between American University and the Leopards of Lafayette College from Easton, Pa. The Eagles have never lost to LC, including four wins since AU joined the Patriot League. Don't let that fool you, though -- Lafayette has come within single-digits of winning in four of those games, including losing in overtime, 64-61, on Feb. 16, 1985. On Feb. 9, 2002, Lafayette dropped a heartbreaker to the Eagles, 63-61, in Easton. The Leopards have struggled so far this season, dropping all 18 of their games. However, LC has been competitive in league play, losing by single digits in three of its five PL contests.

## ON THIS DATE

The Eagles lost to in-city rival Gallaudet, 47-42, on Jan. 30, 1975, to open the season. However, that was just one of four losses on the season and AU finished 7-4 overall, including wins over Georgetown, Immaculata, Catholic, Trinity and Mary Washington. The 1975 season was just the third winning season for a program that began in 1967 with a 1-3 season. The 1975 season ended on a heartbreaking note, with a one-point loss to Georgetown, 53-52.

## UP NEXT

American hosts Army on Super Bowl Sunday beginning at 3 p.m. AU will be celebrating Hall of Fame weekend, as it inducts track greats Dave Reinhart and Gary Cohen and men's basketball legend Brian Gilgeous. After that, the Eagles will play their last regular season non-conference game, when they travel to the University of Maryland-Eastern Shore on Wednesday, Feb. 4, for a 7 p.m. start.

## SPRIGGS NO. 3 IN NCAA IN STEALS PER GAME

As of Jan. 26, senior guard **Chanel Spriggs** is ranked third in the National Collegiate Athletic Association's Division I in steals per game with 3.8 steals in each game which she has played. Spriggs has currently nabbed 64 steals in 17 games. The 5-7 Sunderland, Md., native was leading the nation in steals, at 4.2 per game earlier this season. Spriggs, who is known for her thievery, set AU's career steals record earlier this season when she pilfered six balls from UMBC. She currently has 281 steals and continues to stretch her lead in that category every game. Spriggs also holds the top two spots in the record book for steals in a single season. In 2001-02, Spriggs snagged 110 steals. She followed that season up with a 107-steal effort in 2002-03. Spriggs is currently on pace for 102 steals this season.

## CHASING 1,000

Junior forward **Chanel Hunt** currently has 827 career points, including 417 points last season (14.4 ppg). Hunt needs to average 17.3 ppg over the 10 remaining regular season games to reach the 173 points needed to attain 1,000 career points. Hunt is averaging 10.5 ppg so far this season. If Hunt can attain her 14.4 ppg scoring average from last season, she will score her 1,000th point on Feb. 20, 2004, at home against Holy Cross. Hunt would be just the 11th Eagle in school history to reach four-digits in scoring. Felicia Young is the school's all-time leading scorer, with 1,708 points.

Meanwhile, senior guard **Chanel Spriggs** is also chasing down the 1,000-point barrier, albeit in a less traditional way. The 5-7 Sunderland, Md., native played her freshman season (1999-2000) at NCAA Division III St. Mary's College of Maryland. She scored 229 points that season (8.5 ppg), and has scored 753 points in her three seasons at American, giving her 982 career points. At Spriggs' current pace (she is averaging 9.7 ppg this season), she will reach 1,000 points against Army at home on Feb. 1.

## DEFENSE ... DEFENSE ... DEFENSE ...

A hallmark of the AU squads under coach **Shann Hart**'s tenure has been defense, and plenty of it. The 2003-04 Eagles are no different. This year's version of the team ranks 15th in NCAA Division I in steals per game (12.2/game) and is holding its opponents to just 59.8 points per game. If the Eagles can maintain that average, they would go down as arguably the best defensive squad in school history. The 2002-03 Eagles set a school record for least points per game allowed, at 64.6, and the 2003-04 AU squad could surpass that.

## Scouting Report

**Lafayette:** The Leopards haven't won yet this season, but it's not because of lack of talent. LC is led offensively by senior forward **Colleen Fitzpatrick**, who is averaging 14.9 ppg, good for seventh in the Patriot League. Fitzpatrick is shooting an astounding .598 from the field, tops in the Patriot League by nearly four percentage points. She is also the top free-throw shooter in the league, hitting almost 86 percent of her attempts from the charity stripe.

The Leopards, who average a league-low 58.9 ppg as a team, certainly miss the scoring of sophomore **Katie Kokolus**, a 5-10 guard/forward who was averaging 13.3 ppg when she went down for the season with a torn ACL in her knee.

The Leopards, however, can hit their free throws. LC has hit a league-high 75 percent of its free throws.

Several players on the 2003-04 Eagles have either already broken records or have a chance to make their marks on the AU career record books. Here is a list of those players and their superlatives:

<b>Chanel Hunt</b>	<i>Points</i>	Has 827 points, with a chance to become just the 11th Eagle to surpass the 1,000-point barrier this season.
	<i>Rebounds</i>	Has 494 career rebounds, with a chance to break into the school's top-10. If Hunt repeats her 212 rebound performance from last season, she will finish her junior season ranked seventh in career rebounds with 582, and would have a chance of breaking the school record of 881 career rebounds, set by Mary Klima from 1994 to 1998. Recently cracked into the school's all-time top-10 in steals, with 183. If Hunt replicates her 83-steal effort from last season, she will move into second all-time at AU in steals.
	<i>Steals</i>	
<b>Kaitlin Schuyler</b>	<i>Three-pointers Made</i>	Currently ranks second in career three-points, with 121. She has an outside shot of breaking the school record of 147, set by Kari Gaskins from 1995 to 1999. She would need to average more than two three-pointers per game for the rest of the season. In the 2003-04 season, Schuyler is averaging 1.71 three-pointers per game. Currently ranks 10th, hitting .281 of her attempts.

## EAGLES WELCOME TRANSFER

Sophomore forward **Abby Lipskis** has joined American after transferring from the University of Rhode Island. The 6-2 Lipskis, who played her prep ball in Norfolk, Va., for Norfolk Collegiate, played in 18 games as a freshman, starting three, and averaged 1.4 ppg and 1.9 rpg. Due to NCAA transfer rules, Lipskis will not be eligible to play for AU until mid-way through the 2004-05 season. However, Lipskis has been practicing with the team and could figure to be a post presence in the Patriot League come 2005.
