#### The Coaches

American University is coached by **Shann Hart** (Norfolk State '88), who is in her fourth season leading the Eagles, and seventh overall as a collegiate head coach. Hart has a career record of 120-90 [.571]. Hart led American to 18 wins last season, the most since the 1997-98 season. She is assisted by **Glenn Rigney** (Miami '79), **Deb Reardon** (Assumption '86), **Brian Johnson** (Drexel '98) and graduate manager **Quintina Walker** (William & Mary '02).

Army is coached by **Sherry Abbey-Nowatzki** (Fredonia '89), who is in her eighth season with the Black Knights. Abbey-Nowatzki owns a career record of 91-120 (.431), including a 72-92 (.439) record at Army. Abbey-Nowatzki is assisted by **Tom Spina**, **Lorraine Morrissey** and **Keith Abbey**.

# AMERICAN UNIVERSITY WOMEN'S BASKETBALL



## LAST TIME OUT

American University women's basketball shot 57.1 percent in the second half and pulled away late in a 72-54 victory over the Lafayette Leopards Friday in Bender Arena.

With the Eagles dominating inside the paint with 34 points to Lafayette's 10 and AU's aggressive defense forcing 30 turnovers for 35 points, the Eagles improved to 4-2 in the Patriot League and 9-9 overall.

The Eagles opened the game with a 17-4 run, ending at 9:35, but the Leopards responded with a nine-point streak of their own to bring the score to 17-13. With a steal and a lay-up by **Kaitlin Schuyler** (Baltimore, Md./Mercy) at 6:11 the Eagles were able to surge ahead. **Tara Williams** (Newport News, Va./Heritage) hit a three-pointer after four offensive rebounds by the Eagles to put the score to 25-18 with 3:19 left. The Eagles closed out the half leading 27-20.

The Eagles extended their lead with an 8-3 run that ended 3:30 into the second half. With a three-pointer at 11:02 by Schuyler, the Eagles continued to pull ahead, pushing the score to 48-33. The Leopards fought back and brought the game back within seven, but another three-pointer by Schuyler at 3:28 put the score at 65-44.

Schuyler led the Eagles with 16 points, shooting four-for-eight from the three-point land, while **Chanel Hunt** (Raleigh, N.C./Ravenscroft) added 14 points and six boards. Williams posted a career-high eight points and three boards.

Kristen Doherty led the Leopards with 16 points, including 4-4 from the free throw line. Lafayette falls to 0-19 on the season, 0-6 in the Patriot League.

## THE OPPONENT AND THE HISTORY

This is the eighth meeting between the Black Knights of the United States Military Academy and American University. The Eagles hold a 4-3 advantage in the series, but Army has won three of the last five encounters, including a 78-73 win over the Eagles in last year's Patriot League Semifinals held at the Show Place Arena in Upper Marlboro, Md. The Black Knights opened the 2003-04 season with a five-game win streak, but have since gone 6-8. Army has lost three of its last five games, including league losses to Lehigh and Navy. In their last contest, the Black Knights lost to arch-rival Navy, 75-73.

## ON THIS DATE

The Eagles defeated UNC-Wilmington, 76-71, on Feb. 1, 1998. The win was the last in a three-game win streak, part of a 23-7 campaign. The 1997-98 Eagles' 23 wins are a school record. That team earned AU's only berth in a postseason tournament, with an invitation to the WNIT. American lost in the first round of the WNIT, 77-68, to St. Joseph's on March 13, 1998. The 18 wins last season were the most wins by an Eagle women's basketball squad since that 1997-98 team.

## UP NEXT

American travels to the Eastern shore of Maryland to take on the Hawks of the University of Maryland-Eastern Shore in a non-conference tilt. Game time is set for 7 p.m.

## SPRIGGS NO. 3 IN NCAA IN STEALS PER GAME

As of Jan. 26, senior guard **Chanel Spriggs** is ranked third in the National Collegiate Athletic Association's Division I in steals per game with 3.8 steals in each game which she has played. Spriggs has currently nabbed 64 steals in 17 games. The 5-7 Sunderland, Md., native was leading the nation in steals, at 4.2 per game earlier this season. Spriggs, who is known for her thievery, set AU's career steals record earlier this season when she pilfered six balls from UMBC. She currently has 281 steals and continues to stretch her lead in that category every game. Spriggs also holds the top two spots in the record book for steals in a single season. In 2001-02, Spriggs snagged 110 steals. She followed that season up with a 107-steal effort in 2002-03. Spriggs is currently on pace for 102 steals this season.

## CHASING 1,000

Junior forward **Chanel Hunt** currently has 841 career points, including 417 points last season (14.4 ppg). Hunt needs to average 17.7 ppg over the nine remaining regular season games to reach the 159 points needed to attain 1,000 career points. Hunt is averaging 10.7 ppg so far this season. If Hunt can attain her 14.4 ppg scoring average from last season, she will score her 1,000th point on Feb. 20, 2004, at home against Holy Cross. Hunt would be just the 11th Eagle in school history to reach four-digits in scoring. Felicia Young is the school's all-time leading scorer, with 1,708 points.

Meanwhile, senior guard **Chanel Spriggs** is also chasing down the 1,000-point barrier, albeit in a less traditional way. The 5-7 Sunderland, Md., native played her freshman season (1999-2000) at NCAA Division III St. Mary's College of Maryland. She scored 229 points that season (8.5 ppg), and has scored 763 points in her three seasons at American, giving her 992 career points. At Spriggs' current pace (she is averaging 9.7 ppg this season), she will reach 1,000 points today.

## DEFENSE ... DEFENSE ... DEFENSE ...

A hallmark of the AU squads under coach **Shann Hart**'s tenure has been defense, and plenty of it. The 2003-04 Eagles are no different. This year's version of the team ranks 15th in NCAA Division I in steals per game (12.2/game) and is holding its opponents to just 59.4 points per game. If the Eagles can maintain that average, they would go down as arguably the best defensive squad in school history. The 2002-03 Eagles set a school record for least points per game allowed, at 64.6, and the 2003-04 AU squad could surpass that.

## Scouting Report

**Army:** The Black Knights' senior forward **Katie Macfarlane** is as dominating a presence in the post as they come in the Patriot League. The 6-0 upstate, N.Y. native is averaging a league-high 19.3 ppg, hitting 55 percent of her shots, has demonstrated an ability to hit an occasional three-pointer, hauls down nearly 10 boards per game, dished 25 dimes and blocked 17 shots.

Head coach **Sherry Abbey-Nowatzki** and her staff have assembled a competent supporting cast for Macfarlane. Junior guard/forward **Shavonne Holden**, who stands in at 6-0 as well, is chipping in just over 10 ppg and is second on the squad with 6.3 rpg.

Army's outside presence is provided by freshman phenom **Jen Hansen**, who is hitting 32 percent of her treys (32-100), and **Haley Edwards**, who knocks down 43 percent outside the arc.

## ASSAULTING THE CAREER RECORD BOOKS

Several players on the 2003-04 Eagles have either already broken records or have a chance to make their marks on the AU career record books. Here is a list of those players and their superlatives:

<b>Chanel Hunt</b>	<i>Points</i>	Has 841 points, with a chance to become just the 11th Eagle to surpass the 1,000-point barrier this season.
	<i>Rebounds</i>	Has 500 career rebounds, with a chance to break into the school's top-10. If Hunt repeats her 212 rebound performance from last season, she will finish her junior season ranked seventh in career rebounds with 582, and would have a chance of breaking the school record of 881 career rebounds, set by Mary Klima from 1994 to 1998. Recently cracked into the school's all-time top-10 in steals, with 185. If Hunt replicates her 83-steal effort from last season, she will move into second all-time at AU in steals.
	<i>Steals</i>	
<b>Kaitlin Schuyler</b>	<i>Three-pointers Made</i>	Currently ranks second in career three-points, with 125. She has an outside shot of breaking the school record of 147, set by Kari Gaskins from 1995 to 1999. She would need to average more than two three-pointers per game for the rest of the season. In the 2003-04 season, Schuyler is averaging 1.71 three-pointers per game. Currently ranks 10th, hitting .281 of her attempts.

	<i>Assists</i>	Her 286 career assists puts her fifth on AU's all-time list. Will likely move into fourth place by the end of the season.

## EAGLES WELCOME TRANSFER

Sophomore forward **Abby Lipskis** has joined American after transferring from the University of Rhode Island. The 6-2 Lipskis, who played her prep ball in Norfolk, Va., for Norfolk Collegiate, played in 18 games as a freshman, starting three, and averaged 1.4 ppg and 1.9 rpg. Due to NCAA transfer rules, Lipskis will not be eligible to play for AU until mid-way through the 2004-05 season. However, Lipskis has been practicing with the team and could figure to be a post presence in the Patriot League come 2005.
