American University is coached by **Shann Hart** (Norfolk State '88), who is in her fourth season leading the Eagles, and seventh overall as a collegiate head coach. Hart has a career record of 120-90 [.571]. Hart led American to 18 wins last season, the most since the 1997-98 season. She is assisted by **Glenn Rigney** (Miami '79), **Deb Reardon** (Assumption '86), **Brian Johnson** (Drexel '98) and graduate manager **Quintina Walker** (William & Mary '02).

UMES is coached by **Surina Dixon** (Mississippi Valley State '83), who is in her fourth season with the Hawks. Dixon owns a career record of 22-52 (.297), all at UMES. Dixon is assisted by **Will-Ethel Thomas** and **Tianna Hayes**.

AMERICAN UNIVERSITY WOMEN'S BASKETBALL



LAST TIME OUT

Chanel Spriggs and Joanna Barnes combined for 17 first half points to give the American University women's basketball team early control over Army. The Eagles built an 18-point in the first half and eventually raised it to 25, before finally coming away with a 74-52 victory.

Spriggs and Barnes were catalysts in the opening stanza, but Chanel Hunt added seven points as well. Kimeshia Junkins capped off the first 20 minutes with a layup at 1:00 to give AU its largest lead at 32-14. The Eagles shot 46.4 percent in the half and held a 20-13 advantage in rebounding.

The second half was more of the same as the Black Knights could not get any closer than 14 (32-18) after hitting the first two buckets of the half. However, the Eagles scored nine of the next 11 points and established a 41-20 lead. Kim Salem made two layups and hit a short jumper to score the first six points of the mini-run and Spriggs finished it off with a layup and free throw. Later in the half a Salem layup gave the Eagles a 25-point lead (55-30), the largest lead of the game with 8:42 left in the game. Army got no closer than 19 the rest of the way.

Barnes led all scorers with 15 points on seven-of-11 shooting and she led AU in rebounding with 11. It was the first double-double of her career. Spriggs finished with 14 points on five-of-seven shooting while Salem had 13 points and five rebounds. Kaitlyn Schuyler scored 10 points, dished out five assists and recorded four steals.

Katie MacFarlane, the preseason Patriot League Player of the Year, led the Black Knights with 14 points and 13 rebounds. Lindsay Brent managed 12 points and four rebounds in 22 minutes.

THE OPPONENT AND THE HISTORY

This is the 10th meeting between the Hawks of the University of Maryland-Eastern Shore and American University, with the Eagles holding an 8-1 advantage in the series. UMES' only victory came on Feb. 1, 1995, when the Hawks dropped 72 points on AU in a three-point win. UMES is in the midst of a two-game losing streak, and has lost three of its last five games. Earlier this season, the Hawks skidded to a seven-game losing streak.

ON THIS DATE

The Eagles defeated in-city rival Catholic University on Feb. 4, 1975, 55-30. The win -- the first of that season -- was part of a 7-4 season, the most successful season in AU's nine-year history at the time. The 1975 season ended with a one point loss to another in-city rival, Georgetown, 53-52.

UP NEXT

American returns to Patriot League action with a road trip to Lewisburg, Pa., to take on the Bison of Bucknell University on Saturday, Feb. 7. Game time is set for 1 p.m. The Eagles will then host Navy on Feb. 11 at 7 p.m.

SPRIGGS NO. 3 IN NCAA IN STEALS PER GAME

As of Jan. 26, senior guard **Chanel Spriggs** is ranked third in the National Collegiate Athletic Association's Division I in steals per game with 3.8 steals in each game which she has played. Spriggs has currently nabbed 64 steals in 17 games. The 5-7 Sunderland, Md., native was leading the nation in steals, at 4.2 per game earlier this season. Spriggs, who is known for her thievery, set AU's career steals record earlier this season when she pilfered six balls from UMBC. She currently has 281 steals and continues to stretch her lead in that category every game. Spriggs also holds the top two spots in the record book for steals in a single season. In 2001-02, Spriggs snagged 110 steals. She followed that season up with a 107-steal effort in 2002-03. Spriggs is currently on pace for 102 steals this season.

CHASING 1,000

Junior forward **Chanel Hunt** currently has 850 career points, including 417 points last season (14.4 ppg). Hunt needs to average 18.75 ppg over the eight remaining regular season games to reach the 1500 points needed to attain 1,000 career points. Hunt is averaging 10.6 ppg so far this season. If Hunt can attain her 14.4 ppg scoring average from last season, she will score her 1,000th point on Feb. 20, 2004, at home against Holy Cross. Hunt would be just the 11th Eagle in school history to reach four-digits in scoring. Felicia Young is the school's all-time leading scorer, with 1,708 points.

1,000 POINT SCORER?

With two points today against UMES, senior guard **Chanel Spriggs** will have eclipsed the 1,000-point barrier, albeit in a less traditional way. The 5-7 Sunderland, Md., native played her freshman season (1999-2000) at NCAA Division III St. Mary's College of Maryland. She scored 222 points that season (8.5 ppg), and has scored 777 points in her three seasons at American, giving her 999 career points.

DEFENSE ... DEFENSE ... DEFENSE ...

A hallmark of the AU squads under coach **Shann Hart's** tenure has been defense, and plenty of it. The 2003-04 Eagles are no different. This year's version of the team ranks 15th in NCAA Division I in steals per game (12.2/game) and is holding its opponents to just 59.1 points per game. If the Eagles can maintain that average, they would go down as arguably the best defensive squad in school history. The 2002-03 Eagles set a school record for least points per game allowed, at 64.6, and the 2003-04 AU squad could surpass that.

Scouting Report

UMES: The Hawks have struggled so far this season, compiling a 5-12 record, including dropping their last two games.

UMES is led offensively by **Tiffany Winkfield**, who averages a double-double with 14.1 ppg and 10.5 rpg. The 6-2 center leads the team in shooting percentage, hitting just over 49 percent of her attempts from the field. **Laconia Hatcher** chips in 12.9 ppg, but hits just 32.7 percent of her shots. **Octavia Thompson** also checks in at double figures, with 10.9 ppg.

The Hawks do not feature much of an outside game, hitting just 27 percent of their three-point attempts. **Rachael Goodwin** and **Erica Bennett** are both shooting better than 38 percent from downtown, but have hit just seven and six treys, respectively.

ASSAULTING THE CAREER RECORD BOOKS

Several players on the 2003-04 Eagles have either already broken records or have a chance to make their marks on the AU career record books. Here is a list of those players and their superlatives:

<u>Player</u>	<u>Record</u>	<u>Notes</u>
Chanel Hunt	<i>Points</i>	Has 850 points, with a chance to become just the 11th Eagle to surpass the 1,000-point barrier this season.
	<i>Rebounds</i>	Has 505 career rebounds, with a chance to break into the school's top-10. If Hunt repeats her 212 rebound performance from last season, she will finish her junior season ranked seventh in career rebounds with 582, and would have a chance of breaking the school record of 881 career rebounds, set by Mary Klima from 1994 to 1998. Recently cracked into the school's all-time top-10 in steals, with 188. If Hunt replicates her 83-steal effort from last season, she will move into second all-time at AU in steals.
	<i>Steals</i>	
Kaitlin Schuyler	<i>Three-pointers Made</i>	Currently ranks second in career three-pointers, with 125. She has an outside shot of breaking the school record of 147, set by Kari Gaskins from 1995-99. She would need to average more than two three-pointers per game for the rest of the season. In the 2003-04 season, Schuyler is averaging 1.71 three-pointers per game. Currently ranks 10th, hitting .286 of her attempts.

Chanel Spriggs	<i>Assists</i>	Her 291 career assists puts her fifth on AU's all-time list. Will likely move into fourth place by the end of the season.
	<i>Steals</i>	Surpassed the previous record of 245 steals earlier this season vs. UMBC. Currently has 286 career steals.
	<i>Shooting Pct.</i>	Currently shooting .450, which would place her 10th on the school list.
	<i>Assists</i>	Currently has 207 career assists, eight shy of 10th all-time at AU.

EAGLES WELCOME TRANSFER

Sophomore forward Abby Lipskis has joined American after transferring from the University of Rhode Island. The 6-2 Lipskis, who played her prep ball in Norfolk, Va., for Norfolk Collegiate, played in 18 games as a freshman, starting three, and averaged 1.4 ppg and 1.9 rpg. Due to NCAA transfer rules, Lipskis will not be eligible to play for AU until mid-way through the 2004-05 season. However, Lipskis has been practicing with the team and could figure to be a post presence in the Patriot League come 2005.
