The Coaches

American University is coached by **Shann Hart** (Norfolk State '88), who is in her fourth season leading the Eagles, and seventh overall as a collegiate head coach. Hart has a career record of 120-90 [.571]. Hart led American to 18 wins last season, the most since the 1997-98 season. She is assisted by **Glenn Rigney** (Miami '79), **Deb Reardon** (Assumption '86), **Brian Johnson** (Drexel '98) and graduate manager **Quintina Walker** (William & Mary '02).

Bucknell is coached by **Kathy Fedorjaka** (Fairfield '90), who is in her seventh season with the Bison. Fedorjaka owns a career record of 170-110 (.607), including a 103-72 (.589) record at Bucknell. Fedorjaka is assisted by **Scott Foulis**, **Michelle Simons** and **Laurie Scherer**.

AMERICAN UNIVERSITY WOMEN'S BASKETBALL



LAST TIME OUT

The American University women's basketball team put up its third-highest point total of the season Wednesday at the University of Maryland Eastern Shore, but the Hawks outgunned the Eagles in a 80-73 win at the Hytche Athletic Center in AU's last regular season non-conference game.

After AU's **Joanna Barnes** tied the game at 29 a piece at the 2:38 mark of the first half, UMES went on an 11-0 run to take a commanding 40-29 lead. Only a three-pointer by **Chanel Hunt** with seconds left in the first stanza could stop the run.

The teams traded baskets for much of the early part of the second half, until UMES' Laconia Hatcher hit consecutive three-pointers to extend a nine-point Hawk lead to 15 with 12:25 left in the game. The Hawks continued to build their lead and held a 19-point advantage with just 7:44 remaining.

American began to chip away at the lead, whittling it down to five points with 3:20 left on a layup by **Chanel Spriggs**. However, UMES hit seven-of-10 free throws down the stretch to prevent any further hope of a comeback for the Eagles.

Hunt hit six-of-11 shots to finish with 17 points, but foul trouble limited her to just 22 minutes. Meanwhile, Spriggs surpassed 1,000 collegiate points. With her 15 points, Spriggs, who spent her first year at NCAA Division III St. Mary's College (Md.), now has 792 points at American. Spriggs added five rebounds and five steals.

UMES shot 50 percent for the game (30-of-60) and outrebounded AU, 47-29. The Hawks were led by Erica Bennett, who had 24 points, and Tiffany Winkfield, who had 16 points and 20 rebounds, including six offensive boards.

THE OPPONENT AND THE HISTORY

This is the 11th meeting between the the Bison of Bucknell and American University. The Eagles hold a 6-3 advantage, including a 3-2 record in Lewisburg, Pa. AU has won the last three meetings, including the one earlier this season, when the Eagles' **Kaitlin Schuyler** hit a layup at the buzzer for a 50-49 win. AU swept the season series last year, with a 75-74 win in Lewisburg, Pa., and a 72-60 win in Washington. The Bison are currently struggling, having lost three of their last four games.

ON THIS DATE

The Eagles defeated in-city rival Gallaudet, 47-46, on Feb. 7, 1974. The win was part of a school record-setting 7-6 season, in which the Eagles accumulated more wins than any other team in school history. That record only last two seasons, however, until the 1975-76 squad finished with 11 wins.

UP NEXT

American faces the United States Naval Academy on Wednesday, Feb. 11 at 7 p.m. in a rematch of an epic battle from earlier this season. In the first matchup, American came away from Annapolis, Md., with a 51-42 victory despite shooting just 15.6 percent in the first half and 25 percent for the game. In that game, American scored just 13 first-half points, but exploded in the second stanza for 38 points and the win. After the Navy game, AU returns to the road to head to Bethlehem, Pa., to face the Lehigh Mountain Hawks.

SPRIGGS NO. 3 IN NCAA IN STEALS PER GAME

As of Feb. 2, senior guard **Chanel Spriggs** is tied for sixth in the National Collegiate Athletic Association's Division I in steals per game with 3.6 steals in each game which she has played. Spriggs has currently nabbed 74 steals in 20 games. The 5-7 Sunderland, Md., native was leading the nation in steals, at 4.2 per game earlier this season. Spriggs, who is known for her thievery, set AU's career steals record earlier this season when she pilfered six balls from UMBC. She currently has 281 steals and continues to stretch her lead in that category every game. Spriggs also holds the top two spots in the record book for steals in a single season. In 2001-02, Spriggs snagged 110 steals. She followed that season up with a 107-steal effort in 2002-03. Spriggs is currently on pace for 102 steals this season.

CHASING 1,000

Junior forward **Chanel Hunt** currently has 867 career points, including 417 points last season (14.4 ppg). Hunt needs to average 19.0 ppg over the seven remaining regular season games to reach the 150 points needed to attain 1,000 career points. Hunt is averaging 10.9 ppg so far this season. If Hunt can attain her 14.4 ppg scoring average from last season, she will score her 1,000th point on Feb. 20, 2004, at home against Holy Cross. Hunt would be just the 11th Eagle in school history to reach four-digits in scoring. Felicia Young is the school's all-time leading scorer, with 1,708 points.

DEFENSE ... DEFENSE ... DEFENSE ...

A hallmark of the AU squads under coach **Shann Hart**'s tenure has been defense, and plenty of it. The 2003-04 Eagles are no different. This year's version of the team ranks 15th in NCAA Division I in steals per game (12.1/game) and is holding its opponents to just 60.1 points per game. If the Eagles can maintain that average, they would go down as arguably the best defensive squad in school history. The 2002-03 Eagles set a school record for least points per game allowed, at 64.6, and the 2003-04 AU squad could surpass that.

EAGLES WELCOME TRANSFER

Sophomore forward **Abby Lipskis** has joined American after transferring from the University of Rhode Island. The 6-2 Lipskis, who played her prep ball in Norfolk, Va., for Norfolk Collegiate, played in 18 games as a freshman, starting three, and averaged 1.4 ppg and 1.9 rpg. Due to NCAA transfer rules, Lipskis will not be eligible to play for AU until mid-way through the 2004-05 season. However, Lipskis has been practicing with the team and could figure to be a post presence in the Patriot League come 2005.

Scouting Report

Bucknell: Senior forward **Desire Almind** is an absolute force under the basket. She is hitting 48 percent of her shots, averaging 17.4 ppg and ripping down nearly 14 boards per contest, tops in the NCAA. She also has a nice touch from the line, shooting 78 percent from the charity stripe. Almind is also second on the team in assist, with 55, and has swatted away 45 shots on the season. Almind has led the Bison in scoring in 13 of their 20 games.

Complementing Almind is freshman **Lindsay Hollobaugh**, who checks in at 15.1 ppg and is shooting 42 percent from the field.

Bucknell has struggled as of late, losing three of its last four games. The Bison sit at 2-5 in the Patriot League. In Bucknell's last two games, the team lost by 12 to Colgate and 16 to Holy Cross, both at home.

ASSAULTING THE CAREER RECORD BOOKS

Several players on the 2003-04 Eagles have either already broken records or have a chance to make their marks on the AU career record books. Here is a list of those players and their superlatives:

<u>Player</u>	<u>Record</u>	<u>Notes</u>
Chanel Hunt	<i>Points</i>	Has 867 points, with a chance to become just the 11th Eagle to surpass the 1,000-point barrier this season.
	<i>Rebounds</i>	Has 509 career rebounds, with a chance to break into the school's top-10. If Hunt repeats her 212 rebound performance from last season, she will finish her junior season ranked seventh in career rebounds with 582, and would have a chance of breaking the school record of 881 career rebounds, set by Mary Klima from 1994 to 1998.
	<i>Steals</i>	Recently cracked into the school's all-time top-10 in steals, with 188. If Hunt replicates her 83-steal effort from last season, she will move into second all-time at AU in steals.
Kaitlin Schuyler	<i>Three-pointers Made</i>	Currently ranks second in career three-pointers, with 127. She has an outside shot of breaking the school record of 147, set by Kari Gaskins from 1995-99. She would need to average more than three three-pointers per game for the rest of the season. In the 2003-04 season, Schuyler is averaging 1.71 three-pointers per game.
	<i>3-pt. Shooting Pct.</i>	Currently ranks 10th, hitting .285 of her attempts.
	<i>Assists</i>	Her 295 career assists puts her fourth on AU's all-time list.
Chanel Spriggs	<i>Steals</i>	Surpassed the previous record of 245 steals earlier this season vs. UMBC. Currently has 291 career steals.
	<i>Shooting Pct.</i>	Currently shooting .449, which would place her 10th on the school list.
	<i>Assists</i>	Currently has 210 career assists, five shy of 10th all-time at AU.
