AMERICAN UNIVERSITY WOMEN'S BASKETBALL



LAST TIME OUT

The American University women's basketball team held Bucknell University's two leading scorers to just 14 combined points, but couldn't overcome a stifling defensive effort by the Bison in a 51-39 loss Saturday at Sojka Pavilion.

The Eagles jumped ahead of BU early, going up by eight points, 17-9, at the 8:31 mark of the first half. However, BU stepped up its defensive effort and held AU scoreless for nearly eight minutes as the Bison went on a 12-0 run to take a 21-17 lead. **Kim Salem** halted the run by hitting a pair of free throws, but American went into the lockerroom trailing 23-19 after Bucknell's Lindsey Hollobaugh hit two free throws of her own.

Early in the second stanza, American began chipping away at the Bison's lead, eventually tying the game at 28 at the 14:48 mark of the second half. Once again, Bucknell ramped up its defensive intensity and held the Eagles scoreless over the next 6:49. BU surged ahead by 10, 38-28, and AU would get no closer than five the rest of the way.

American held Desire Almind, BU's leading scorer at 17.4 points per game entering today's contest, to just five points, and the Bison's second-leading scorer, Lindsey Hollobaugh, who was averaging 15.1 ppg coming into today, to just nine points.

American drops to 10-11 overall and 5-3 in the Patriot League. The Eagles were led by Salem, who had eight points and six rebounds, and **Angel McNatt**, who finished with eight points in just nine minutes of action.

Bucknell, which improves to 10-11 overall and 3-5 in the Patriot League, was led by Lillian Drumgold, who hit four-of-six shots and finished with 14 points.

THE OPPONENT AND THE HISTORY

This is the 19th meeting between American University and the Midshipmen of the United States Naval Academy, with AU holding a 11-7 advantage in the series. Navy has won just once against American in Washington, D.C., and never in Bender Arena. The Mids only win in the Capitol City came in their first visit on Dec. 4, 1979. Since joining the Patriot League, AU has split both season series with Navy, with each team winning two contests each on their home floors. However, the Eagles bucked that trend earlier this season when they defeated Navy, 51-42, in Annapolis, Md.

ON THIS DATE

The Eagles defeated Cheyney State 79-34 on Feb. 11, 1987. The 45-point margin of victory is the fifth-largest in school history. In addition, the win was one of 20 that season, the first-ever 20-win season in school history. The season ended with a 74-62 loss to James Madison University in the finals of the Colonial Athletic Association Tournament.

UP NEXT

American travels to Bethlehem, Pa., on Valentine's Day to square off against the Mountain Hawks of Lehigh University. Game time is set for 1 p.m. In an earlier meeting this season between Lehigh and the Eagles, LU came away from Washington, D.C., with a 69-55 victory. The Mountain Hawks are tied atop the Patriot League standings with Colgate. After the Lehigh game, American will attempt to defeat Holy Cross for the first time in school history, when the Crusaders invade Bender Arena on Friday, Feb. 20, for a 5:30 p.m. game.

SPRIGGS NO. 9 IN NCAA IN STEALS PER GAME

As of Feb. 9, senior guard **Chanel Spriggs** is ranked ninth in the National Collegiate Athletic Association's Division I in steals per game with 3.5 steals in each game which she has played. Spriggs has currently nabbed 74 steals in 21 games. The 5-7 Sunderland, Md., native was leading the nation in steals, at 4.2 per game, earlier this season. Spriggs, who is known for her thievery, set AU's career steals record earlier this season when she pilfered six balls from UMBC. She currently has 291 steals and continues to stretch her lead in that category every game. Spriggs also holds the top two spots in the record book for steals in a single season. In 2001-02, Spriggs snagged 110 steals. She followed that season up with a 107-steal effort in 2002-03. Spriggs is currently on pace for 102 steals this season.

CHASING 1,000

Junior forward **Chanel Hunt** currently has 873 career points, including 417 points last season (14.4 ppg). Hunt needs to average 21.1 ppg over the six remaining regular season games to reach the 127 points needed to attain 1,000 career points. Hunt is averaging 10.7 ppg so far this season. If Hunt can attain her 14.4 ppg scoring average from last season, she will score her 1,000th point on Feb. 20, 2004, at home against Holy Cross. Hunt would be just the 11th Eagle in school history to reach four-digits in scoring. Felicia Young is the school's all-time leading scorer, with 1,708 points.

DEFENSE ... DEFENSE ... DEFENSE ...

A hallmark of the AU squads under coach **Shann Hart**'s tenure has been defense, and plenty of it. The 2003-04 Eagles are no different. This year's version of the team ranks 17th in NCAA Division I in steals per game (11.9/game) and is holding its opponents to just 59.7 points per game. If the Eagles can maintain that average, they would go down as arguably the best defensive squad in school history. The 2002-03 Eagles set a school record for least points per game allowed, at 64.6, and the 2003-04 AU squad could surpass that.

EAGLES WELCOME TRANSFER

Sophomore forward **Abby Lipskis** has joined American after transferring from the University of Rhode Island. The 6-2 Lipskis, who played her prep ball in Norfolk, Va., for Norfolk Collegiate, played in 18 games as a freshman, starting three, and averaged 1.4 ppg and 1.9 rpg. Due to NCAA transfer rules, Lipskis will not be eligible to play for AU until mid-way through the 2004-05 season. However, Lipskis has been practicing with the team and could figure to be a post presence in the Patriot League come 2005.

Scouting Report

Navy: The Midshipmen are coming off a 24-point loss to league-leading Lehigh on Feb. 7. Prior to that, however, Navy had won three consecutive games, its longest winning streak of the season.

The Mids are led offensively by senior guard **Courtney Davidson**, who is averaging 18.0 ppg and has hit a whopping 56 three-pointers on the season. The 5-10 Pennsylvania native is hitting 37 percent of her three-point attempts and 41 percent of her shots from the field. Also contributing offensively is **Adrienne Rosetti**, who checks in at 11.9 ppg, but has had trouble with turnovers, giving the ball away 101 times so far this season.

As a team, Navy hits 32 percent of its three-point attempts, including 35 percent in conference play. The Mids are also solid from the free throw line, hitting 71 percent, but have struggled with turnovers, averaging 19.1 per game.

If Hunt repeats her 212 rebound performance from last season, she will finish her junior season ranked seventh in career rebounds with 582, and would have a chance of breaking the school record of 881 career rebounds, set by Mary Klima from 1994 to 1998. Recently cracked into the school's all-time top-10 in steals, with 192. If Hunt replicates her 83-steal effort from last season, she will move into second all-time at AU in steals.
