Hart has a career record of 124-91 [.577]. Hart led American to 18 wins last season, the most since the 1997-98 season. She is assisted by **Glenn Rigney** (Miami '79), **Deb Reardon** (Assumption '86), **Brian Johnson** (Drexel '98) and graduate manager **Quintina Walker** (William & Mary '02).

Colgate is coached by **Beth Combs** (Illinois '91), who is in her third season with the Raiders. Combs owns a career record of 38-44 (.463), all at Colgate. Combs is assisted by **Shelly Respecki**, **Kim Coon** and **Victoria Best**.

# AMERICAN UNIVERSITY WOMEN'S BASKETBALL



## LAST TIME OUT

American University shot 52 percent in the first period, en route to a 22-point halftime lead over visiting Holy Cross, and cruised to a 81-65 victory Friday at Bender Arena. The victory was the first-ever by the Eagles over Holy Cross, gave AU a season-high three-game win streak and sole possession of first place in the Patriot League.

The Crusaders opened the game with a 4-0 run, but the Eagles gained control and went on a 12-0 run, with **Kaitlin Schuyler** putting the ball in twice from beyond the three point arc. Ending the run at 15:35 with a two-pointer by the Crusaders' Lisa Andrews, the Eagles quickly regained control, going on another run with less than 10 minutes left in the half. The Eagles only allowed Holy Cross four points for the last eight minutes of the first half, and **Joanna Barnes** hit a three-pointer at the buzzer to push the Eagles' lead to 22.

In the second stanza the Eagles continued to push ahead, as **Kim Salem** made a layup to give the American the largest lead of the game at 26 at 16:09. The Crusaders attempted to chip away at the Eagles lead, but were unsuccessful, only coming as close as 12 with 7:11 remaining.

Barnes scored a game-high 19 points and added four boards, while **Chanel Hunt** cracked the 900 point career mark at 13:24, with the first of her 10 points. **Chanel Spriggs** and Salem also accumulated double figures, with 16 points each.

The Crusaders were led by Kristin Popovics posted 17 points, while Mary Rose Campbell had a game-high 10 boards.

With Navy defeating Colgate 68-53 tonight, AU takes the sole possession of first place in the Patriot League at 8-3.

## CRUCIAL MATCHUP

Today's contest is crucial for both teams involved. If AU can win today, its chances of securing the top-seed in the Patriot League Tournament March 5-7 are significantly better. However, if Colgate can pull out the 'W,' it would create yet another tie atop the league standings at 8-4.

## THE OPPONENT AND THE HISTORY

This is the eighth meeting between American University and the Raiders of Colgate University. Colgate has defeated the Eagles just once in the series, in the Patriot League tournament in 2002. However, each game in the series has been tight -- the largest margin of victory was 11 points.

## ON THIS DATE

The Eagles concluded the 1977 season with a 73-68 loss to nearby George Mason University on Feb. 22, 1977. AU played just three games that season, losing two. American lone victory came against Georgetown University, 70-49.

## UP NEXT

The Eagles hit the road for their last two regular season games of this season, traveling to West Point, N.Y., to square off against the United States Military Academy on Thursday, Feb. 26. The Eagles then head southwest to battle the Leopards of Lafayette College on Saturday, Feb. 28.

## THREE IN A ROW!

The Eagles are riding their first three-game win streak of the season. AU has had five two-game win streaks so far this season, but had never been able to put away a third straight victory until Friday against Holy Cross. This season is the mirror opposite of last season, when the Eagles put together one four-game, one five-game and two three-game win streaks.

## SPRIGGS NO. 2 IN NCAA IN STEALS PER GAME

As of Feb. 16, senior guard **Chanel Spriggs** is ranked second in the National Collegiate Athletic Association's Division I in steals per game with 3.7 steals in each game which she has played. Spriggs has currently nabbed 86 steals in 23 games. The 5-7 Sunderland, Md., native was leading the nation in steals, at 4.2 per game, earlier this season. Spriggs, who is known for her thievery, set AU's career steals record earlier this season when she pilfered six balls from UMBC. She currently has 303 steals and continues to stretch her lead in that category every game. Spriggs also holds the top two spots in the record book for steals in a single season. In 2001-02, Spriggs snagged 110 steals. She followed that season up with a 107-steal effort in 2002-03. Spriggs is currently on pace for 101steals in the regular season.

## HUNT TOPS 900-POINT BARRIER

With 10 points against Holy Cross on Friday night, junior forward **Chanel Hunt** surpassed 900 career points at American. The 6-0 North Carolinian now has 909 career points (11.4 ppg). However, it is unlikely Hunt will attain 1,000 career points this season. There are just four guaranteed games left (three regular season, one in the PL Tournament). If the Eagles advance to the PL title game, Hunt would need to average 15.2 ppg to reach 1,000 points.

## DEFENSE ... DEFENSE ... DEFENSE ...

A hallmark of the AU squads under coach **Shann Hart**'s tenure has been defense, and plenty of it. The 2003-04 Eagles are no different. This year's version of the team ranks 17th in NCAA Division I in steals per game (11.9/game) and is holding its opponents to just 58.7 points per game. If the Eagles can maintain that average, they would go down as arguably the best defensive squad in school history. The 2002-03 Eagles set a school record for least points per game allowed, at 64.6, and the 2003-04 AU squad could surpass that.

## Scouting Report

**Colgate:** The Raiders at the Patriot League's best offense, tossing in nearly 72 points each night. Junior **Emily Braseth** and senior **Malissa Burke** lead the way for Colgate, averaging 17.1 ppg and 14.2 ppg, respectively. The Raiders' third-leading scorer, freshman **Molly Patterson**, who checks in with 11.6 ppg, is out indefinitely with an injury. CU can fill it up from the outside, with five players who shoot better than 33 percent from outside the arc.

However, Colgate's not too shabby on defense, either. Five players have more than 30 steals, and the Raiders have forced nearly 100 more turnovers than they've committed.

The pace of the game could be key today. Of Colgate's nine losses, six have come when it has scored fewer than 65 points. Only one of 15 wins have come when the Raiders score less than 65.

## QUIET STANDOUT

Junior forward **Kim Salem** is quietly putting up solid numbers this season. The 6-1 Canadian is averaging 8.8 ppg, 5.1 rpg and is shooting a team-best 54 percent. Salem, who had started just one game in her career before this season, has started 21 of 23 games this season. Salem is also solid at the charity stripe, hitting 73 percent of her free throw attempts.

## ASSAULTING THE CAREER RECORD BOOKS

Several players on the 2003-04 Eagles have either already broken records or have a chance to make their marks on the AU career record books. Here is a list of those players and their superlatives:

<b>Chanel Hunt</b>	<i>Points</i>	Has 909 points, with a chance to become just the 11th Eagle to surpass the 1,000-point barrier this season.
	<i>Rebounds</i>	Has 539 career rebounds, 23 boards away from the school's top-10. If Hunt repeats her 212 rebound performance from last season, she will finish her junior season ranked seventh in career rebounds with 582, and would have a chance of breaking the school record of 881 career rebounds, set by Mary Klima from 1994 to 1998.
	<i>Steals</i>	Has 198 career steals, tied for ninth all-time at AU in career steals.
<b>Kaitlin Schuyler</b>	<i>Three-pointers Made</i>	Currently ranks second in career three-pointers, with 132. She has an outside shot of breaking the school record of 147, set by Kari Gaskins from 1995-99. She would need to average nearly four three-pointers per game for the rest of the season. In the 2003-04 season, Schuyler is averaging 1.67 three-pointers per game.
	<i>3-pt. Shooting Pct.</i>	Currently ranks 10th, hitting .286 of her attempts.
	<i>Assists</i>	Her 309 career assists puts her fourth on AU's all-time list, 31 away from third place.
<b>Chanel Spriggs</b>	<i>Steals</i>	Surpassed the previous record of 245 steals earlier this season vs. UMBC. Currently has 306 career steals. She is just the sixth player in Patriot League history to surpass 300 steals.
	<i>Shooting Pct.</i>	Currently shooting .445, which would place her 10th on the school list.
	<i>Assists</i>	Currently has 220 career assists, ninth all-time at AU. Needs just 11 assists to move up to seventh.

## EAGLES WELCOME TRANSFER

Sophomore forward **Abby Lipskis** has joined American after transferring from the University of Rhode Island. The 6-2 Lipskis, who played her prep ball in Norfolk, Va., for Norfolk Collegiate, played in 18 games as a freshman, starting three, and averaged 1.4 ppg and 1.9 rpg. Due to NCAA transfer rules, Lipskis will not be eligible to play for AU until mid-way through the 2004-05 season. However, Lipskis has been practicing with the team and could figure to be a post presence in the Patriot League come 2005.
