**The Coaches**

American University is coached by **Shann Hart** (Norfolk State '88), who is in her fourth season leading the Eagles, and seventh overall as a collegiate head coach. Hart has a career record of 124-92 [.574]. Hart led American to 18 wins last season, the most since the 1997-98 season. She is assisted by **Glenn Rigney** (Miami '79), **Deb Reardon** (Assumption '86), **Brian Johnson** (Drexel '98) and graduate manager **Quintina Walker** (William & Mary '02).

Army is coached by **Sherri Abbey-Nowatzki** (Fredonia '89), who is in her fifth season with the Black Knights. Abbey-Nowatzki owns a career record of 93-124 (.429), including a 74-96 (.435) record at Army. Abbey-Nowatzki is assisted by **Tom Spina**, **Lorraine Morrissey**, **Meredith Pine** and **Keith Abbey**.

# AMERICAN UNIVERSITY WOMEN'S BASKETBALL



## LAST TIME OUT

American University got 19 points from Chanel Hunt (Raleigh, N.C./Ravenscroft), but it was not enough to overcome the Raiders of Colgate as AU lost, 79-61.

In the first half neither team was able to get on track early and American took its first lead of the game at 6-5 on a layup by **Chanel Spriggs** with 14:50 left in the half. The teams traded baskets for another six minutes before the Eagles were able to take a three-point lead (17-14) with 8:22 remaining. However, Colgate scored 19 of the next 23 points to take a commanding 33-21 lead. American's last lead of the game during the run came at 21-20 after a **Tara Williams** free throw broke a 20-20 tie. Colgate scored the next 13 points before **Joanna Barnes** was able to break the run with a layup and free throw to cut the lead to 11 at the half, 35-24.

Colgate's success in the first half could be attributed to rebounding and defensive pressure. They outrebounded AU 23-14 for the half, caused 15 turnovers and held American to 39.1 percent shooting (9-of-23).

Early in the second half the Raiders continued to dominate. They scored 17 of the first 21 points to build a 24-point lead just six minutes into the half. **Kim Salem** snapped the streak with a layup and then she tipped a pass. After a bit of a scrum, Hunt ended up with the ball at halfcourt and went in for a layup to cut the score to 52-32.

American could not get any closer than 19 until **Angel McNatt** reentered the game with eight minutes remaining. She scored seven straight points for the Eagles and her three-pointer with 5:38 remaining brought AU to within 16 points (65-49). Her last two buckets came after she grabbed defensive rebounds. A couple of possessions later **Kaitlin Schuyler** missed a three, but Hunt followed with the offensive rebound and layup to cut the deficit to 14 points (63-57) with 5:42 remaining.

Hunt then cut the lead to 13 points on a pair of free throws with 2:57 remaining, but that would be as close as the Eagles would get. Hunt finished with 19 points, seven rebounds, five steals and two assists. Spriggs contributed 10 points and six rebounds, while Salem chipped in 10 points and six rebounds.

Colgate was led by Emily Braseth and Malissa Burke, each of whom had 19 points. Milaina Lagzdins hauled down a game-high 19 rebounds.

The loss leaves American at 13-12 on the season, 8-4 in conference play and in a four-way tie for first place in the Patriot League with Colgate, Holy Cross and Lehigh.

## THE OPPONENT AND THE HISTORY

This is the ninth meeting between American University and the Black Knights of Army, with the Eagles holding a 5-3 advantage in the series. Army has lost its last three games, and six of its last eight.

## ON THIS DATE

The Eagles defeated UNC-Wilmington, 97-80, on Feb. 26, 1998. The 97 points tied for fourth-highest in school history.

## UP NEXT

The Eagles conclude the 2003-04 regular season with a matchup against Lafayette College on Saturday, Feb. 28. Game time is set for 1 p.m. After that, the Eagles will look forward to the Patriot League Championship tournament, which kicks off on March 5.

## SPRIGGS NO. 2 IN NCAA IN STEALS PER GAME

As of Feb. 16, senior guard **Chanel Spriggs** is ranked second in the National Collegiate Athletic Association's Division I in steals per game with 3.7 steals in each game which she has played. Spriggs has currently nabbed 86 steals in 23 games. The 5-7 Sunderland, Md., native was leading the nation in steals, at 4.2 per game, earlier this season. Spriggs, who is known for her thievery, set AU's career steals record earlier this season when she pilfered six balls from UMBC. She currently has 310 steals and continues to stretch her lead in that category every game. Spriggs also holds the top two spots in the record book for steals in a single season. In 2001-02, Spriggs snagged 110 steals. She followed that season up with a 107-steal effort in 2002-03. Spriggs is currently on pace for 101steals in the regular season.

## HUNT TOPS 900-POINT BARRIER

With 10 points against Holy Cross on Friday night, junior forward **Chanel Hunt** surpassed 900 career points at American. The 6-0 North Carolinian now has 928 career points (11.5 ppg). However, it is unlikely Hunt will attain 1,000 career points this season. There are just three guaranteed games left (two regular season, one in the PL Tournament). If the Eagles advance to the PL title game, Hunt would need to average 14.4 ppg to reach 1,000 points.

## DEFENSE ... DEFENSE ... DEFENSE ...

A hallmark of the AU squads under coach **Shann Hart's** tenure has been defense, and plenty of it. The 2003-04 Eagles are no different. This year's version of the team ranks 17th in NCAA Division I in steals per game (11.9/game) and is holding its opponents to just 59.7 points per game. If the Eagles can maintain that average, they would go down as arguably the best defensive squad in school history. The 2002-03 Eagles set a school record for least points per game allowed, at 64.6, and the 2003-04 AU squad could surpass that.

## QUIET STANDOUT

Junior forward **Kim Salem** is quietly putting up solid numbers this season. The 6-1 Canadian is averaging 8.9 ppg, 5.2 rpg and is shooting a team-best 54 percent. Salem, who had started just one game in her career before this season, has started 21 of 23 games this season. Salem is also solid at the charity stripe, hitting 73 percent of her free throw attempts. Prior to this season, Salem averaged 2.1 ppg and 1.2 rpg

## Scouting Report

**Army:** The Black Knights are led by Patriot League preseason Player of the Year **Katie Macfarlane**, who averages 19.6 ppg and 9.8 rpg. The 6-0 forward is hitting 56 percent of her shots, including 30 percent from beyond the arc, but has also turned the ball over 102 times this season. **Shavonne Holden** is the only other Black Knight averaging double-figures, with 10.6 ppg, as well as 6.0 rpg.

Army has two legitimate outside threats in **Jen Hansen** and **Haley Edwards**. Hansen has hit 37 treys and is shooting at a 29 percent clip, and Edwards has dialed long distance 36 times and is shooting an astounding 41 percent from downtown.

The Black Knights enter today's game having lost six of their last eight, but they have a one-game winning streak at Christl Arena.

## ASSAULTING THE CAREER RECORD BOOKS

Several players on the 2003-04 Eagles have either already broken records or have a chance to make their marks on the AU career record books. Here is a list of those players and their superlatives:

<u>Player</u>	<u>Record</u>	<u>Notes</u>
<b>Chanel Hunt</b>	<i>Points</i>	Has 928 points, with a chance to become just the 11th Eagle to surpass the 1,000-point barrier this season.
	<i>Rebounds</i>	Has 546 career rebounds, 23 boards away from the school's top-10. If Hunt repeats her 212 rebound performance from last season, she will finish her junior season ranked seventh in career rebounds with 582, and would have a chance of breaking the school record of 881 career rebounds, set by Mary Klima from 1994 to 1998.
	<i>Steals</i>	Has 203 career steals, good for ninth all-time at AU in career steals, and just three from eighth.
<b>Kaitlin Schuyler</b>	<i>Three-pointers Made</i>	Currently ranks second in career three-pointers, with 133. She has an outside shot of breaking the school record of 147, set by Kari Gaskins from 1995-99. She would need to average nearly four three-pointers per game for the rest of the season. In the 2003-04 season, Schuyler is averaging 1.67 three-pointers per game.
	<i>3-pt. Shooting Pct.</i>	Currently ranks 10th, hitting .286 of her attempts.
	<i>Assists</i>	Her 314 career assists puts her fourth on AU's all-time list, 26 away from third place.
<b>Chanel Spriggs</b>	<i>Steals</i>	Surpassed the previous record of 245 steals earlier this season vs. UMBC. Currently has 310 career steals. She is just the sixth player in Patriot League history to surpass 300 steals.
	<i>Shooting Pct.</i>	Currently shooting .445, which would place her 10th on the school list.
	<i>Assists</i>	Currently has 224 career assists, eighth all-time at AU. Needs just seven assists to move up to seventh.

## EAGLES WELCOME TRANSFER

Sophomore forward **Abby Lipskis** has joined American after transferring from the University of Rhode Island. The 6-2 Lipskis, who played her prep ball in Norfolk, Va., for Norfolk Collegiate, played in 18 games as a freshman, starting three, and averaged 1.4 ppg and 1.9 rpg. Due to NCAA transfer rules, Lipskis will not be eligible to play for AU until mid-way through the 2004-05 season. However, Lipskis has been practicing with the team and could figure to be a post presence in the Patriot League come 2005.
