Hart has a career record of 125-92 [.576]. Hart led American to 18 wins last season, the most since the 1997-98 season. She is assisted by **Glenn Rigney** (Miami '79), **Deb Reardon** (Assumption '86), **Brian Johnson** (Drexel '98) and graduate manager **Quintina Walker** (William & Mary '02).

Lafayette is coached by **Tammy Smith** (East Stroudsburg '82), who is in her third season with the Leopards. Smith owns a career record of 119-143 (.454), including a 6-75 (.074) record at Lafayette. Smith is assisted by **LaRonda Murphy**, **Shelby Kealy** and **Ron Hoffman**.

AMERICAN UNIVERSITY WOMEN'S BASKETBALL



LAST TIME OUT

The American University women's basketball team used its defense to smother Army, holding the Black Knights to the fourth-lowest output in recent school history and forcing 34 Army turnovers, and got just enough offense out of Chanel Hunt and Kaitlin Schuyler to win, 49-41, Thursday at Christl Arena.

AU trailed 37-33 with 9:20 remaining in the game, after Army's Megan Flynt hit her third three-pointer of the second half. However, AU stepped up its defense and held the Black Knights scoreless for nearly five minutes while the Eagles scored 10 points to take a 43-37 lead with just less than five minutes left. Army got no closer than five the rest of the way. Schuyler and Hunt combined to go four-for-four from the line over the last minute of the game to ice it for the Eagles.

Army held a 13-11 advantage at the 11:22 mark of the first half, but the Eagles' defense stiffened. AU did not allow the Black Knights to score over the next eight minutes, while the Eagles built up an 11-point lead with 3:34 left in the half. Army's Lindsay Brent finally broke the scoreless streak, but AU went into the locker room with a 28-18 lead. The Eagles forced 17 turnovers and allowed the Black Knights to shoot just 35 percent in the opening period. American also took advantage of nine offensive boards in the first half that led to 11 second-chance points.

Hunt led AU with a game-high 15 points, nine boards and seven steals. Schuyler chipped in 14 points, including four three-pointers, and three steals. Schuyler is now just 10 three-pointers away from tying the school record for most three-point field goals in a career. As a team, American nabbed 20 steals, tied for the seventh-most in school history.

Flynt led Army with 11 points. AU held Katie Macfarlane, the Patriot League's preseason Player of the Year and Army's leading scorer entering the contest at more than 19 points per game, to just seven points.

THE OPPONENT AND THE HISTORY

This is the 11th meeting between American University and the Leopards of Lafayette College. Lafayette has never defeated the Eagles. The closest LC ever came to victory against AU was a two-point loss on Feb. 9, 2002.

ON THIS DATE

The Eagles defeated Richmond, 68-43, in the first round of the Colonial Athletic Association tournament for their 20th win of the season. It was the first 20-win season in school history, but it ended in heartbreaking fashion when AU fell to East Carolina by one point in the second round of the CAA tourney.

UP NEXT

The Eagles play in the first round of the Patriot League Championship Tournament on March 5. Game time is TBA, depending on the outcomes of several other PL games tomorrow.

SPRIGGS NO. 2 IN NCAA IN STEALS PER GAME

As of Feb. 23, senior guard **Chanel Spriggs** is ranked second in the National Collegiate Athletic Association's Division I in steals per game with 3.7 steals in each game which she has played. Spriggs has currently nabbed 93 steals in 25 games. The 5-7 Sunderland, Md., native was leading the nation in steals, at 4.2 per game, earlier this season. Spriggs, who is known for her thievery, set AU's career steals record earlier this season when she pilfered six balls from UMBC. She currently has 310 steals and continues to stretch her lead in that category every game. Spriggs also holds the top two spots in the record book for steals in a single season. In 2001-02, Spriggs snagged 110 steals. She followed that season up with a 107-steal effort in 2002-03. Spriggs is currently on pace for 101steals in the regular season.

HUNT TOPS 900-POINT BARRIER

With 10 points against Holy Cross on Feb. 20, junior forward **Chanel Hunt** surpassed 900 career points at American. The 6-0 North Carolinian now has 943 career points (11.5 ppg). However, it is unlikely Hunt will attain 1,000 career points this season. There are just two guaranteed games left (two regular season, one in the PL Tournament). If the Eagles advance to the PL title game, Hunt would need to average 14.25 ppg to reach 1,000 points.

DEFENSE ... DEFENSE ... DEFENSE ...

A hallmark of the AU squads under coach **Shann Hart's** tenure has been defense, and plenty of it. The 2003-04 Eagles are no different. This year's version of the team ranks 17th in NCAA Division I in steals per game (11.9/game) and is holding its opponents to just 59.7 points per game. If the Eagles can maintain that average, they would go down as arguably the best defensive squad in school history. The 2002-03 Eagles set a school record for least points per game allowed, at 64.6, and the 2003-04 AU squad could surpass that.

QUIET STANDOUT

Junior forward **Kim Salem** is quietly putting up solid numbers this season. The 6-1 Canadian is averaging 8.9 ppg, 5.2 rpg and is shooting a team-best 54 percent. Salem, who had started just one game in her career before this season, has started 21 of 23 games this season. Salem is also solid at the charity stripe, hitting 73 percent of her free throw attempts. Prior to this season, Salem averaged 2.1 ppg and 1.2 rpg

Scouting Report

Lafayette: The Leopards are hurting, literally. Not only have they lost 26 straight games, only one player has played in each of those games due to injuries.

Senior forward **Colleen Fitzpatrick** leads the Leopards, averaging 14.3 ppg and 6.8 rpg. **Kristen Doherty**, the only Lafayette player that has played in all 26 games, is second on the team in scoring with 8.5 ppg. **Tricia Indoe** is new to the starting lineup, and is coming off her first-ever double-double, against Navy.

The Leopards have used 12 different players in their starting lineup so far this season. Fitzpatrick has started all 23 games in which she has played.

Lafayette has been excellent from the line this season, hitting nearly 76 percent of its attempts from the charity stripe.

ASSAULTING THE CAREER RECORD BOOKS

Several players on the 2003-04 Eagles have either already broken records or have a chance to make their marks on the AU career record books. Here is a list of those players and their superlatives:

Chanel Hunt	<i>Points</i>	Has 943 points, with a chance to become just the 11th Eagle to surpass the 1,000-point barrier this season.
	<i>Rebounds</i>	Has 555 career rebounds, 14 boards away from the school's top-10. If Hunt repeats her 212 rebound performance from last season, she will finish her junior season ranked seventh in career rebounds with 582, and would have a chance of breaking the school record of 881 career rebounds, set by Mary Klima from 1994 to 1998.
	<i>Steals</i>	Has 210 career steals, good for ninth all-time at AU in career steals, and just three from eighth.
Kaitlin Schuyler	<i>Three-pointers Made</i>	Currently ranks second in career three-pointers, with 137. She has shot of breaking the school record of 147, set by Kari Gaskins from 1995-99. In the 2003-04 season, Schuyler is averaging 1.67 three-pointers per game.
	<i>3-pt. Shooting Pct.</i>	Currently ranks 10th, hitting .286 of her attempts.
	<i>Assists</i>	Her 314 career assists puts her fourth on AU's all-time list, 26 away from third place.
Chanel Spriggs	<i>Steals</i>	Surpassed the previous record of 245 steals earlier this season vs. UMBC. Currently has 313 career steals. She is just the sixth player in Patriot League history to surpass 300 steals.
	<i>Shooting Pct.</i>	Currently shooting .445, which would place her 10th on the school list.
	<i>Assists</i>	Currently has 226 career assists, eighth all-time at AU. Needs just five assists to move up to seventh.

EAGLES WELCOME TRANSFER

Sophomore forward **Abby Lipskis** has joined American after transferring from the University of Rhode Island. The 6-2 Lipskis, who played her prep ball in Norfolk, Va., for Norfolk Collegiate, played in 18 games as a freshman, starting three, and averaged 1.4 ppg and 1.9 rpg. Due to NCAA transfer rules, Lipskis will not be eligible to play for AU until mid-way through the 2004-05 season. However, Lipskis has been practicing with the team and could figure to be a post presence in the Patriot League come 2005.
