## LAST TIME OUT

With a chance at earning the first seed in the upcoming Patriot League Championship Tournament next week, the American University women's basketball team shot just 34 percent for the game and lost to previously winless Lafayette College, 64-61, Saturday at Kirby Sports Center.

The Eagles' offensive woes started early, as they missed their first six shots of the game and trailed 9-0 five minutes into the game. AU did not get its first basket until the 14:30 mark, when **Angel Jordan** hit a floater in the lane. Lafayette built up a leads as large as 11 points at the halfway point of the first stanza. However, the Eagles stormed back, going on a 25-12 run to end the half down just three, 31-28.

AU came out of the locker room and scored the first three points of the second period to tie the game at 31 a piece with 18:37 left. The teams traded buckets until, with 13:23 left, American took its first lead of the game, 41-40, on a free throw by senior guard **Chanel Spriggs**. Spriggs finished with a game-high 18 points in the last regular-season game of her career.

The Leopards responded with a mini-run of their own, scoring the next six points to take a 46-41 led with 10:43 left, their largest lead of the half. Lafayette's lead fluctuated between one and five points over the next six minutes, until American took just its second lead of the game, 54-53, on a Spriggs jumper.

Lafayette regained the momentum and the lead when their two seniors – Colleen Fitzpatrick and Elecia Kruike – combined to score the next five points of the game. Fitzpatrick hit a pair of free throws, and then Kruike snagged a steal, went the length of the court and hit a fast-break layup while being fouled. She completed the three-point play, and Lafayette led, 58-54, with just four minutes left.

Lafayette then iced the game by hitting four-of-six free throws down the stretch. AU had a chance to tie the game when Kruike missed two free throws with four seconds left, but **Joanna Barnes'** three-point attempt at the buzzer was tipped and missed its mark.

The Eagles lost despite forcing a season-high 35 turnovers. In addition to her 18 points, Spriggs finished with nine steals and five rebounds.

## THE OPPONENT AND THE HISTORY

This is the 20th meeting between American University and the Midshipmen of the U.S. Naval Academy, but the first in the postseason. AU holds a 12-7 advantage over the Mids, including sweeping the regular season series this year. Navy enters this evening's contest having won three of its last five games, including a win over top-seeded Colgate on Feb. 20. However, the Mids are coming off a loss to arch-rival Army on Feb. 28.

## ON THIS DATE

The Eagles have only won once on March 5, when they defeated Hood College in 1974, 73-43. The win was part of a two-game win streak that helped the Eagles finish 7-6, just their second winning season in the eight year history of the program.

## UP NEXT

The winner of this evening's contest will play on Sunday against the winner of the Lehigh/Army matchup. LU and Army square off at 7:30 p.m. tonight.

## AU IN THE PL TOURNAMENT

The Eagles are 1-2 in the two PL tournaments in which they have participated. AU lost in the first round of its first PL Tournament in 2002 against Colgate, 68-79. The Eagles avenged that loss in the first round in 2003, beating the Raiders 71-65. However, AU lost to Army in the second round, 73-78.

## AU IN THE POSTSEASON

American is 6-20 all-time in the postseason, including its time in the East Coast Conference, the Colonial Athletic Association, the Patriot League and one appearance in the Women's National Invitational Tournament. The Eagles have never won a league championship tournament. AU has participated in two league championship games, in 1987 vs. James Madison (a 62-74 loss) and in 1998 vs. Old Dominion (a 49-82 loss), both in the CAA. In fact, the Eagles have exited in the first round in 10 of 17 league tournaments in which they have participated.

## SPRIGGS NO. 2 IN NCAA IN STEALS PER GAME

As of March 1, senior guard **Chanel Spriggs** is ranked second in the National Collegiate Athletic Association's Division I in steals per game with 3.9 steals in each game which she has played. Spriggs has currently nabbed 105 steals in 27 games. Spriggs, who is known for her thievery, set AU's career steals record earlier this season when she pilfered six balls from UMBC. She currently has 322 steals and continues to stretch her lead in that category every game. Spriggs also holds the top spot in the record book for steals in a single season, with 110 steals in the 2001-02 season. Spriggs needs just six steals to break that record.

## HUNT TOPS 900-POINT BARRIER

With 10 points against Holy Cross on Feb. 20, junior forward **Chanel Hunt** surpassed 900 career points at American. The 6-0 North Carolinian now has 952 career points (11.5 ppg).

## DEFENSE ... DEFENSE ... DEFENSE ...

A hallmark of the AU squads under coach **Shann Hart's** tenure has been defense, and plenty of it. The 2003-04 Eagles are no different. This year's version of the team ranks seventh in NCAA Division I in steals per game (12.2/game) and is holding its opponents to just 59.2 points per game. If the Eagles can maintain that average, they would go down as arguably the best defensive squad in school history. The 2002-03 Eagles set a school record for least points per game allowed, at 64.6, and the 2003-04 AU squad will likely surpass that.

## QUIET STANDOUT

Junior forward **Kim Salem** is quietly putting up solid numbers this season. The 6-1 Canadian is averaging 8.9 ppg, 5.2 rpg and is shooting a team-best 54 percent. Salem, who had started just one game in her career before this season, has started 25 of 27 games this season. Salem is also solid at the charity stripe, hitting 70 percent of her free throw attempts. Prior to this season, Salem averaged 2.1 ppg and 1.2 rpg

## Scouting Report

**Navy:** The Midshipmen are led by the outside/inside combo of **Courtney Davidson** and **Adrienne Rosetti**. Davidson leads the Mids with 17.3 ppg, and has hit 72 three pointers at a 36 percent clip. Meanwhile, Rosetti is second in scoring, at 12/1 ppg, and first in rebounding, with 7.2 rpg.

However, Davidson and Rosetti aren't the only options for the Mids. **Abi Campbell** is another deep threat, hitting 38 percent of her three-ball attempts (42-112). In addition, **Maile Shimoda** runs Navy's show, and has an impressive two-to-one assist to turnover ratio, with 170 assists on the season, which tops the PL.

Navy's weaknesses include a short bench (they typically only go seven or eight deep) and turnover struggles. Three of five starters have given the ball away more than 82 times this season.

## ASSAULTING THE CAREER RECORD BOOKS

Several players on the 2003-04 Eagles have either already broken records or have a chance to make their marks on the AU career record books. Here is a list of those players and their superlatives:

<u>Player</u>	<u>Record</u>	<u>Notes</u>
<b>Chanel Hunt</b>	<i>Points</i>	Has 952 points, with a chance to become just the 11th Eagle to surpass the 1,000-point barrier this season.
	<i>Rebounds</i>	Has 561 career rebounds, eight boards away from the school's top-10. If Hunt repeats her 212 rebound performance from last season, she will finish her junior season ranked seventh in career rebounds with 582, and would have a chance of breaking the school record of 881 career rebounds, set by Mary Klima from 1994 to 1998.
	<i>Steals</i>	Has 214 career steals, good for eighth all-time at AU in career steals, and just 30 from second.
<b>Kaitlin Schuyler</b>	<i>Three-pointers Made</i>	Currently ranks second in career three-pointers, with 137. She has shot of breaking the school record of 147, set by Kari Gaskins from 1995-99. In the 2003-04 season, Schuyler is averaging 1.67 three-pointers per game.
	<i>3-pt. Shooting Pct.</i>	Currently ranks 10th, hitting .286 of her attempts.
	<i>Assists</i>	Her 317 career assists puts her fourth on AU's all-time list, 23 away from third place.
<b>Chanel Spriggs</b>	<i>Steals</i>	Surpassed the previous record of 245 steals earlier this season vs. UMBC. Currently has 322 career steals. She is just the sixth player in Patriot League history to surpass 300 steals.
	<i>Shooting Pct.</i>	Currently shooting .445, which would place her 10th on the school list.
	<i>Assists</i>	Currently has 227 career assists, eighth all-time at AU. Needs just four assists to move up to seventh.

## PATRIOT LEAGUE PRESEASON PREDICTIONS

The PL's coaches and SIDs must be psychic. American was selected by the Patriot League's coaches and sports information directors to finish second in the league, which they did -- just one game behind Colgate. However, 10-time Patriot League regular season champion Holy Cross was selected to win the league this year. The Crusaders were a near-unanimous selection to win the regular season title, with 14 out of a possible 16 first-place votes and 98 points. Holy Cross wrapped up the four seed in the PL tournament with an 8-6 record in PL play.

## HISTORY OF THE NO. 2 SEED

The No. 2 seed has a 20-11 record in the 13-year history of the Patriot League Tournament. Two seeds have made it to the championship game seven times, but have won just once (Bucknell in 2002). The two seed has exited in the first round twice (Bucknell in 1999 and 2001). American was the No. 2 seed in the 2003 tournament, and made it to the second round before losing to No. 6 seed Army, 78-70.
