Hart has a career record of 126-93 [.575]. Hart led American to 18 wins last season, the most since the 1997-98 season. She is assisted by **Glenn Rigney** (Miami '79), **Deb Reardon** (Assumption '86), **Brian Johnson** (Drexel '98) and graduate manager **Quintina Walker** (William & Mary '02).

Lehigh is coached by **Sue Troyan** (Dickinson '88), who is in her eighth season with the Mountain Hawks. Troyan owns a career record of 121-133 (.476), all at Lehigh. Troyan is assisted by **Jim Sexton**, **Tempie Brown** and **Dorothy Super**.

# AMERICAN UNIVERSITY WOMEN'S BASKETBALL



## LAST TIME OUT

The American University women's basketball team's offense exploded in the second half, scoring 49 points on 57 percent shooting in the period, to give the Eagles an 85-73 win over the U.S. Naval Academy Friday in the quarterfinals of the Patriot League Tournament at the Show Place Arena.

Navy raced ahead of AU early, building leads as large as nine points in the opening period. The Midshipmen led 17-8 at the 11:46 mark of the first, but AU went on a 28-18 run over the next nine minutes to take its first lead since the first bucket of the game. The two teams headed to the lockerroom knotted up at 36 a piece.

It was the second half where American took it to the Mids. AU never trailed in the period, and hit 12-of-21 shots and 25-of-32 free throws to finish with a season-high 85 points. The Eagles held Navy scoreless for more than three minutes, between 14:55 and 11:38, while they built up a 10-point lead, 52-42. The Mids responded with a 21-13 run of their own to close within two points with four minutes left in the game. However, AU hit 14-of-16 free throws in the last four minutes to seal the victory. **Chanel Hunt** hit eight-of-10 during that stretch. Overall, AU hit 31 free throws, in 40 attempts, the fourth-most free throws made in a game in school history. AU scored 12 of its final 14 points of the game from the free throw line.

Six Eagles finished in double-figures, led by **Chanel Spriggs'** 16 points in just 24 minutes of action. Hunt finished with 15 points and eight boards and went 11-of-13 from the line. The rebounds pushed Hunt into 10th place all-time at AU in career rebounds. In addition, senior **Angel McNatt** had 14 points in just 17 minutes, **Joanna Barnes** had 13 points, senior **Kaitlin Schuyler** had 10 points and **Kim Salem** had 13 points and nine rebounds. **Jenyce Woodruff** nabbed a career-high nine rebounds in just her sixth start of the season. Salem, Schuyler, Spriggs and Hunt played much of the last 10 minutes of the contest with four fouls each.

## THE OPPONENT AND THE HISTORY

This is the 12th meeting between the Mountain Hawks of Lehigh University and American University, with the Eagles holding an 8-3 advantage in the series. The two teams split the season series, as Lehigh won at American on Jan. 17, 69-55, but American responded with a 55-48 win over the Mountain Hawks in Stabler Arena. American holds a 4-2 advantage in the series since the Eagles joined the Patriot League.

## ON THIS DATE

The Eagles defeated Colgate, 71-65, in the opening round of last year's Patriot League Championship Tournament. However, AU lost its next game, to Army, in the league semifinals. The 2002-03 squad finished the season with 18 wins, the most since the 1997-98 team won 23 contests. Last year's AU squad set a record for regular season league wins, with 10.

## UP NEXT

The winner of today's contest will play in the Patriot League Championship Game. If Colgate advances to the title game, the game will be held in Hamilton, N.Y. However, if Bucknell defeats Colgate and the Eagles are victorious, the game will be held in Washington, D.C. at Bender Arena. The Championship tilt is set for Wednesday, March 10, beginning at 7 p.m., and the game will be broadcast live on DIRECTV.

## AU IN THE PL TOURNAMENT

The Eagles are 2-2 in the three PL tournaments in which they have participated, after Friday's win over Navy. AU lost in the first round of its first PL Tournament in 2002 against Colgate, 68-79. The Eagles avenged that loss in the first round in 2003, beating the Raiders 71-65. However, AU lost to Army in the second round, 73-78.

## AU IN THE POSTSEASON

American is 7-20 all-time in the postseason, including its time in the East Coast Conference, the Colonial Athletic Association, the Patriot League and one appearance in the Women's National Invitational Tournament. The Eagles have never won a league championship tournament. AU has participated in two league championship games, in 1987 vs. James Madison (a 62-74 loss) and in 1998 vs. Old Dominion (a 49-82 loss), both in the CAA. In fact, the Eagles have exited in the first round in 10 of 18 league tournaments in which they have participated.

## SPRIGGS NO. 2 IN NCAA IN STEALS PER GAME

As of March 1, senior guard **Chanel Spriggs** is ranked second in the National Collegiate Athletic Association's Division I in steals per game with 3.9 steals in each game which she has played. Spriggs has currently nabbed 105 steals in 27 games. Spriggs, who is known for her thievery, set AU's career steals record earlier this season when she pilfered six balls from UMBC. She currently has 322 steals and continues to stretch her lead in that category every game. Spriggs also holds the top spot in the record book for steals in a single season, with 110 steals in the 2001-02 season. Spriggs needs just six steals to break that record.

## HUNT TOPS 900-POINT BARRIER

With 10 points against Holy Cross on Feb. 20, junior forward **Chanel Hunt** surpassed 900 career points at American. The 6-0 North Carolinian now has 967 career points (11.5 ppg).

## DEFENSE ... DEFENSE ... DEFENSE ...

A hallmark of the AU squads under coach **Shann Hart's** tenure has been defense, and plenty of it. The 2003-04 Eagles are no different. This year's version of the team ranks *seventh* in NCAA Division I in steals per game (12.6/game) and is holding its opponents to just 59.7 points per game. If the Eagles can maintain that average, they would go down as arguably the best defensive squad in school history. The 2002-03 Eagles set a school record for least points per game allowed, at 64.6, and the 2003-04 AU squad will likely surpass that.

## BAD OMEN?

American is just 2-6 in games in which they've played two days earlier. They have played eight such games so far this season, including much of the Patriot League schedule (which usually schedules Friday/Sunday games), and the Eagles have beaten only Howard (81-56) on Nov. 23, 2003, and Army (74-52) on Feb. 1.

## Scouting Report

**Lehigh:** **Jessica DePalo** is a force for the Mountain Hawks. The 6-1 center is averaging 18.8 ppg and 7.8 boards per contest, while hitting 52 percent of her shots. She has also blocked a team-high 54 shots.

DePalo's supportint cast includes guard **Dawn Gorynski**, who tallies 9.0 ppg and is lethal from outside the arc. The 5-6 point guard is hitting better than 39 percent of her treys this season and has knocked down 50 three-pointers. PL All-Freshman Team member **Sara Ellis** is also a deep threat, having hit 43 treys at a 31 percent clip.

The Mountain Hawks have struggled with turnovers this season, giving the ball up 592 times (21.1 per game), which forcing just 17.3 turnovers per game. Lehigh has also struggled to score at times this season, averaging just 63.4 points per contest.

## ASSAULTING THE CAREER RECORD BOOKS

Several players on the 2003-04 Eagles have either already broken records or have a chance to make their marks on the AU career record books. Here is a list of those players and their superlatives:

<u>Player</u>	<u>Record</u>	<u>Notes</u>
<b>Chanel Hunt</b>	<i>Points</i>	Has 967 points, with a chance to become just the 11th Eagle to surpass the 1,000-point barrier this season.
	<i>Rebounds</i>	Has 569 career rebounds, which ties her for 10th place all-time at AU. If Hunt repeats her 212 rebound performance from last season, she will finish her junior season ranked seventh in career rebounds with 582, and would have a chance of breaking the school record of 881 career rebounds, set by Mary Klima from 1994 to 1998.
	<i>Steals</i>	Has 215 career steals, good for eighth all-time at AU in career steals, and just 30 from second.
<b>Kaitlin Schuyler</b>	<i>Three-pointers Made</i>	Currently ranks second in career three-pointers, with 137. She has shot of breaking the school record of 147, set by Kari Gaskins from 1995-99. In the 2003-04 season, Schuyler is averaging 1.67 three-pointers per game.
	<i>3-pt. Shooting Pct.</i>	Currently ranks 10th, hitting .284 of her attempts.
	<i>Assists</i>	Her 321 career assists puts her fourth on AU's all-time list, 19 away from third place.
<b>Chanel Spriggs</b>	<i>Steals</i>	Surpassed the previous record of 245 steals earlier this season vs. UMBC. Currently has 324 career steals. She is just the sixth player in Patriot League history to surpass 300 steals.
	<i>Shooting Pct.</i>	Currently shooting .444, which would place her 10th on the school list.
	<i>Assists</i>	Currently has 227 career assists, eighth all-time at AU. Needs just four assists to move up to seventh.

## PATRIOT LEAGUE PRESEASON PREDICTIONS

The PL's coaches and SIDs must be psychic. American was selected by the Patriot League's coaches and sports information directors to finish second in the league, which they did -- just one game behind Colgate. However, 10-time Patriot League regular season champion Holy Cross was selected to win the league this year. The Crusaders were a near-unanimous selection to win the regular season title, with 14 out of a possible 16 first-place votes and 98 points. Holy Cross wrapped up the four seed in the PL tournament with an 8-6 record in PL play, and exited in the first round of the tournament Friday with a loss to fifth-seeded Bucknell, the Crusaders' first-ever first-round loss.

## HISTORY OF THE NO. 2 SEED

The No. 2 seed has a 21-11 record in the 13-year history of the Patriot League Tournament. Two seeds have made it to the championship game seven times, but have won just once (Bucknell in 2002). The two seed has exited in the first round twice (Bucknell in 1999 and 2001). American was the No. 2 seed in the 2003 tournament, and made it to the second round before losing to No. 6 seed Army, 78-70.
