Hart has a career record of 113-81 [.582]. Hart led American to 18 wins last season, the most since the 1997-98 season. She is assisted by **Glenn Rigney** (Miami '79), **Deb Reardon** (Assumption '86), **Brian Johnson** (Drexel '98) and graduate manager **Quintina Walker** (William & Mary '02).

Mount St. Mary's is coached by **Vanessa Blair** (Mount St. Mary's '92), who is in her sixth season with the Mountaineers. Blair owns a career record of 78-67 (.538), all at The Mount. Blair is assisted by **Marlin Chinn** (Hampton '92) **Mark Zacher** (Indiana [Pa.] '80) and **T.J. Burns** (Mount St. Mary's '03).

# AMERICAN UNIVERSITY WOMEN'S BASKETBALL



## LAST TIME OUT

American University women's basketball's wild second-half comeback, from down 24 with just over 12 minutes remaining, fell short Sunday as the Eagles lost to Loyola College, 64-59.

Down 52-28 with 12:17 remaining in the second stanza, a steal and subsequent fast-break layup by **Angel McNatt** launched 31-9 run that put the Eagles down by just two points at the 1:05 mark. American had a chance to tie, but could not convert a pair of free throws.

After Loyola's Katie Scherle hit one of two free throws to give the Greyhounds a three-point lead, McNatt's three-point attempt rimmed out. **Kim Salem** grabbed the offensive rebound and the Eagles called timeout. Junior point guard **Joanna Barnes'** jumper fell short and the Greyhounds iced the game with two free throws.

McNatt led American, which falls to 2-1, with a career-high 18 points, including a career-high four treys. Salem chipped in 11 points, and **Chanel Hunt** added 10 points and eight boards.

## THE OPPONENT AND THE HISTORY

This is the 10th meeting of American and Mount St. Mary's. The Eagles have won four of the last five contests, including the last two matchups. American enters this afternoon's action with a 2-1 record, coming off wins over UNC Asheville, 52-48, and Howard, 81-56, and a loss to Loyola, 64-59. The Mountaineers enter this evening's contest 1-3, capturing their first victory with a 74-66 win over Rider on Monday. The Mount fell to Radford to open the season, and then dropped to Alaska-Anchorage and Brigham Young in the Great Alaska Shootout.

## ON THIS DATE

The Eagles defeated the University of Maryland-Eastern Shore, 61-56, on Dec. 3, 1985. The win was the second in a four-game win streak, part of the Eagles' first-ever 20-win season. American finished the 1985-86 season 20-7, including wins over Georgetown, Richmond and George Mason. The season ended in heartbreaking fashion, with a one-point loss to East Carolina in the second round of the Colonial Athletic Association tournament.

## THIEVERY

With 225 career steals, senior guard **Chanel Spriggs** ranks third on the AU all-time career steals list. If she continues on her current pace -- she nabbed 110 steals in her sophomore season and 107 last year, good for sixth in the NCAA in steals per game -- Spriggs will easily break the all-time school record of 244 steals, set by Jody Thornton between 1983 and 1987. Spriggs 110 steals in the 2001-2002 season set the school's single-season record for most steals. She established new AU, Patriot League and Bender Arena records with 11 steals against Holy Cross on Jan. 26, 2003. In addition, after her eight steals in three games this season, Spriggs is just six steals away from cracking the top-10 for career steals in Patriot League history. Lafayette's Heidi Caruso, who played for the Leopards between 1990 and 1994, holds the Patriot League career steals record with 354. Meanwhile, **Chanel Hunt's** 83 steals in the 2002-03 season were the fourth most in a season in the history of the program. Hunt has 159 career steals, just 17 steals away from breaking into the schools top-10.

## UP NEXT

American faces No. 18 (ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll) Arizona in the first round of the Arizona Basketball Classic on Saturday, Dec. 6, beginning at 5:30 p.m. (MST).

# AMERICAN UNIVERSITY WOMEN'S BASKETBALL



## HOME, SWEET HOME

AU women's basketball has accumulated a 116-77 (.601) record in the friendly confines of Bender Arena, since the facility opened its doors on Jan. 23, 1988. American has had a winning home record in 12 of the last 13 seasons, going 102-51 (.667) during that span. Last season, the Eagles racked up 10 wins against just two losses in Bender. American hosts 12 regular season home games this season. The Eagles opened up Bender in style so far this season, with wins over UNC Asheville and Howard.

## KEEPIN' IT CLOSE

AU's 52-48 season-opening win over UNC Asheville and its 64-59 loss to Loyola continue a trend it set last season. The Eagles participated in 13 games in 2002-03 in which the final score was decided by single digits. American was victorious in nine of those 13 contests, with two of the losses coming in overtime.

## PATRIOT LEAGUE PRESEASON PREDICTIONS

American has been selected by the Patriot League's coaches and sports information directors to finish second in the league. Ten-time Patriot League regular season champion Holy Cross was selected to win the league this year. The Crusaders were a near-unanimous selection to win the regular season title, with 14 out of a possible 16 first-place votes and 98 points. The Eagles were selected second with 84 points.

Meanwhile, junior forward **Chanel Hunt** was selected by the league's coaches and SIDs to the 2003-04 Preseason All-Patriot League Team. She was joined by Courtney Davidson from Navy, Katie Macfarlane from Army, Maggie Fontana from Holy Cross and Desire Almind from Bucknell. Hunt was among the league leaders last season in scoring (14.4 ppg), rebounding (7.3 rpg), assists (2.5 apg), steals (2.5 spg) and field goal percentage (.507).

## HUNT(ING) 1,000 POINTS

After three games this season, junior forward **Chanel Hunt** has 673 career points (11.4 ppg), including 417 points last season (14.4 ppg). Hunt needs to average 13 ppg over the 27 scheduled regular season games to reach the 351 points needed to attain 1,000 career points. If Hunt maintains her 14.4 ppg scoring average from last season, she will score her 1,000th point on Feb. 20, 2004, at home against Holy Cross. Hunt would be just the 11th Eagle in school history to reach four-digits in scoring. Felicia Young is the school's all-time leading scorer, with 1,708 points.

## RETURNING EAGLES

Three starters and nine letterwinners return from last year's 18-11 squad. Starters **Chanel Hunt** (14.4 ppg, 7.3 rpg), **Chanel Spriggs** (10.9 ppg, 3.7 spg) and **Joanna Barnes** (6.2 ppg, 3.7 rpg) made up 48.4 percent of the Eagles offense last season. Meanwhile, key reserves **Kaitlin Schuyler** (5.2 ppg, 2.6 apg), **Angel McNatt** (2.9 ppg), **Kim Salem** (2.7 ppg) and **Jenyce Woodruff** (2.5 ppg) all will look to make significant contributions this year.

## BALANCED SCORING

Six different players took home top-scoring honors in individual games in the 2002-03 season. **Chanel Hunt** led the way, leading the team in scoring in 12 of the Eagles 29 contests, including a season-high 34 points against Navy on Feb. 11, 2003. **Chanel Spriggs** led the team in scoring in nine games, while **Katryn Costenbader** scored a team-high in points in six games. **Maria Werries** led the way three times and **Joanna Barnes'** 18 points versus Bucknell on Feb. 8, 2003, was her lone game leading the team in scoring. **Spriggs** led the Eagles in games one and two with 15 points against UNC Asheville and 21 against Howard.

## Scouting Report

**Mount St. Mary's:** Senior **Myrian Baccouche** leads the Mountaineers, scoring 22.8 ppg over the team's first four games. The 5-10 forward/guard is shooting 42 percent from the field, including 40 percent from outside the arc. Senior **Adrienne Harris**, a 5-4 senior point guard, chips in 13.3 ppg and leads The Mount with 15 assists. Freshman **Jillian Franklin**, a 6-4 freshman center, leads the Mountaineers on the boards, grabbing 8.3 rpg.

The Mountaineers captured their first victory of the 2003-04 season on Monday when they defeated Rider, 74-66. Baccouche tallied 20 points and grabbed six rebounds, and is now only 11 points away from 1,000 in her career.

The Mount as a team is shooting 38 percent from the floor, but has hit 33 percent of its three-point attempts. The Mountaineers have also hit on 72 percent of their free throw attempts.

## DISHING THE ROCK

Senior guard **Kaitlin Schuyler** has 233 assists in her three-plus seasons at AU, good for seventh all-time. She is just 30 assists from sixth-place. Schuyler passed out a career-high 83 assists (3.5 apg) in the 2001-02 season, and followed that up with 75 assists in 29 games (2.6 apg) last year. In her freshman campaign, Schuyler dished out 65 assists in 23 games (2.8 apg). For her career, Schuyler has given out 2.9 assists per game. If she continues on that pace, Schuyler has a chance to move into fourth place on the school's all-time career assists list, behind Danielle Blackburn (340), Karen Jenkins (396) and the school's all-time leader, Jody Thornton, who had 693 assists between 1983 and 1987. Schuyler leads to 2003-04 Eagles with eight assists, including tallying six dimes versus Howard.

## HOT SHOOTING

Through three games this season, five AU players are shooting better than 46 percent. Reserve guard **Courtney Spellacy**, a transfer from Div. III Lewis & Clark, leads the way, hitting three of her four shots (.750), including three-of-three in her Div. I debut versus Howard. **Chanel Spriggs**, the Eagles' leading scorer at 14.3 ppg, has hit 16 of 26 shots (.615). **Kim Salem**, a 6-1 starting center, has hit 11 of her 16 shots (.688) while averaging 9.3 ppg, second-best on the squad. Junior **Jenyce Woodruff** has hit five of her 10 shots (.500), while backup guard **Angel McNatt** has hit on seven of her 15 attempts (.467), including four-of-nine three-pointers versus Loyola.

## THE NEWCOMERS

Head coach Shann Hart and her coaching staff bolstered the Eagles depth this past offseason by bringing in a highly touted recruiting class. Freshman **Kimeshia Junkins**, a 6-3 center from Columbus, Ohio, will be counted on to provide the Eagles with a post presence. Senior **Courtney Spellacy** is a 5-8 guard who transferred to American from Div. III Lewis & Clark College, where she earned two letters and was named Rookie of the Year. In addition, Spellacy finished second in the nation in assists per game (5.6) in her sophomore season and fifth in free throw percentage (89 percent). Freshman guard **Tara Williams** comes to American from Newport News, Va., where she starred for Heritage High School. During her time at Heritage, Williams was named to the All-District Second Team three times, was named the *Daily Press* Player of the Week, was a two-time team MVP and earned the best defensive player award. Transfer **Tala Hadavi** joins the Eagles from Virginia Commonwealth University. Hadavi will sit out this season because of NCAA transfer rules.

## BUILDING ON SUCCESS

The Eagles' 18 wins last season were tied for the third-most in school history, behind a 23-win season in 1997-98 and two 20-win seasons in 1985-86 and 1986-87. AU's four league losses last season were the second least for the program, and its .621 win percentage was the fifth-best. The Eagles' 1,888 points were the fifth-most all-time, while the 2002-03 Eagles scoring defense, which gave up just 64.6 ppg and allowed opponents to shoot just .376 overall, was the best ever for an American squad. Last year's squad also ranked in the top-five in school history in average scoring margin, field goals made, field goal attempts, three-point field goals, three-point attempts, three-point defense, rebounds, assists, blocked shots, steals, turnovers caused, personal fouls and disqualifications.

## BUILDING ON SUCCESS, PART II

If past results against the Eagles 2003-04 opponents are any indication of future performance, AU should have a successful season. The Eagles have a combined 102-51 (.667) record against the opponents on this season's schedule, and have a winning record when playing 13 of their 16 opponents which they have previously played. The Eagles records against 2003-04 opponents are as follows: Army, 4-3; Brown, 5-4; Bucknell, 6-3; Colgate, 5-1; Elon, 0-1; Holy Cross, 0-5; Howard, 8-6; Lafayette, 10-0; Lehigh, 7-2; Liberty, 4-0; Loyola (Md.), 6-2; UMBC, 5-3; UMES, 8-1; Mt. St. Mary's, 4-5; Navy, 10-7; and William & Mary, 26-11.
