Hart has a career record of 115-83 [.581]. Hart led American to 18 wins last season, the most since the 1997-98 season. She is assisted by **Glenn Rigney** (Miami '79), **Deb Reardon** (Assumption '86), **Brian Johnson** (Drexel '98) and graduate manager **Quintina Walker** (William & Mary '02).

William & Mary is coached by **Debbie Taylor** (William & Mary '86), who is in her sixth season with the Tribe. Taylor owns a career record of 36-81 (.336), all at William & Mary. Taylor is assisted by **Candace Crabtree**, **Waynetta Veney** and **Katie Marsh**.

## LAST TIME OUT

The American University women's basketball team, led by **Chanel Spriggs'** 17 points, seven rebounds, six steals and three assists, moved to 5-2 on the season with a 57-41 victory over the University of Maryland-Baltimore County on Thursday. The six steals by Spriggs vaulted her into first place on the AU all-time career steals list.

The Eagles held leads of 12-0 four minutes into the contest and 22-17 at halftime, but UMBC stormed out of the lockerroom in the second stanza. The Retrievers scored the first five points of the half and tied the contest at 22 at the 16:12 mark of the second half. American went on a 15-3 run, including nine points from Spriggs, to grab a 12-point lead with 10 minutes left.

UMBC came back again, this time to within six points with 1:44 remaining, on consecutive three-pointers by Maria Santos and Courtney Doughman. However, senior guard **Kaitlin Schuyler** responded with a three-pointer to pull ahead by nine, and the Eagles went four-for-four from the free throw line to ice the game. Schuyler finished with 12 points, including a three-for-five effort from beyond the arc, five assists and four steals

American's defense forced 25 Retriever turnovers – off of which the Eagles scored 31 points – and allowed UMBC to shoot just 37 percent for the game. American committed a season-low 13 turnovers in the contest.

## THE OPPONENT AND THE HISTORY

This is the 38th meeting between American and William & Mary, former league foes when AU was in the Colonial Athletic Association. Although AU leads the overall series, 26-11, W&M has won three of the last four meetings.

## ON THIS DATE

The Eagles defeated local rival Georgetown, 70-597, on Dec. 20, 1997. The win was the last time the Eagles have defeated the Hoyas. GU is located just a few blocks away from AU's scenic Northwest Washington, D.C. campus.

## SPRIGGS SETS SCHOOL CAREER STEALS RECORD

With six steals on Thursday versus UMBC, senior guard **Chanel Spriggs** took over the top spot in American University school history for steals. Spriggs now has 245 steals, one more than the former leader Jody Thornton, who played between 1983 and 1987. As of Dec. 8, Spriggs was averaging 3.7 steals per game, good for 16th in the NCAA.

Spriggs 110 steals in the 2001-2002 season set the school's single-season record for most steals. She established new AU, Patriot League and Bender Arena records with 11 steals against Holy Cross on Jan. 26, 2003. In addition, after her 22 steals in six games this season, Spriggs cracked into the top-10 for career steals in Patriot League history. Lafayette's Heidi Caruso, who played for the Leopards between 1990 and 1994, holds the Patriot League career steals record with 354.

## UP NEXT

American takes 10 days off for the holidays and returns to action on Tuesday, Dec. 30, when it squares off against Elon at Bender Arena beginning at 7 p.m. The contest against the Phoenix is the Eagles' only home matchup in the month of December and marks a homecoming after more than a month of road games. AU's last home game was a 81-56 win over Howard on Nov. 23.

# AMERICAN UNIVERSITY WOMEN'S BASKETBALL



## HOME, SWEET HOME

AU women's basketball has accumulated a 116-77 (.601) record in the friendly confines of Bender Arena, since the facility opened its doors on Jan. 23, 1988. American has had a winning home record in 12 of the last 13 seasons, going 102-51 (.667) during that span. Last season, the Eagles racked up 10 wins against just two losses in Bender. American hosts 12 regular season home games this season. The Eagles opened up Bender in style so far this season, with wins over UNC Asheville and Howard.

## THAT'S THE TICKET!

American's five wins in seven games this season have all come when the Eagles shoot .400 or better. In AU's two losses -- at Loyola and at Arizona -- American shot just .373 and .379.

## HITTING TRIPLE DIGITS FROM BEHIND THE ARC

With two three-pointers versus Utah State in the consolation game of the Fiesta Bowl Classic, hosted by the University of Arizona, senior guard **Kaitlin Schuyler** eclipsed 100 career three-pointers, the fourth Eagle to eclipse 100 in a career. After the UMBC game, Schuyler now has 103 treys.

## PATRIOT LEAGUE PRESEASON PREDICTIONS

American has been selected by the Patriot League's coaches and sports information directors to finish second in the league. Ten-time Patriot League regular season champion Holy Cross was selected to win the league this year. The Crusaders were a near-unanimous selection to win the regular season title, with 14 out of a possible 16 first-place votes and 98 points. The Eagles were selected second with 84 points.

Meanwhile, junior forward **Chanel Hunt** was selected by the league's coaches and SIDs to the 2003-04 Preseason All-Patriot League Team. She was joined by Courtney Davidson from Navy, Katie Macfarlane from Army, Maggie Fontana from Holy Cross and Desire Almind from Bucknell. Hunt was among the league leaders last season in scoring (14.4 ppg), rebounding (7.3 rpg), assists (2.5 apg), steals (2.5 spg) and field goal percentage (.507).

## HUNT(ING) 1,000 POINTS

After seven games this season, junior forward **Chanel Hunt** has 714 career points (11.5 ppg), including 417 points last season (14.4 ppg). Hunt needs to average 14.3 ppg over the 20 remaining regular season games to reach the 286 points needed to attain 1,000 career points. Hunt is averaging 10.5 ppg so far this season. If Hunt can attain her 14.4 ppg scoring average from last season, she will score her 1,000th point on Feb. 20, 2004, at home against Holy Cross. Hunt would be just the 11th Eagle in school history to reach four-digits in scoring. Felicia Young is the school's all-time leading scorer, with 1,708 points.

## SCORING ANGEL

Junior **Angel Jordan** is scoring just 4.1 ppg this season. However, Jordan, who transferred from Delaware St. before last season and was required to sit out last season because of NCAA rules, has played just 49 minutes (7.0/game). If you were to prorate her offensive output to 40 minutes/game, Jordan would be averaging nearly 28 ppg. Jordan exhibited her ability to score in bunches at the Fiesta Bowl Classic, hosted by the University of Arizona, on Dec. 6-7 when she scored 14 points versus the U. of A., in just nine minutes, and nine points versus Utah St. in just 14 minutes of action.

### Scouting Report

**W&M:** The Tribe return to action for the first time since Dec. 7, when they lost to Vermont, 75-72 in overtime. W&M is now 2-4 on the season, having lost its first three contests of the season.

William & Mary is led by freshman point guard **Kyle DeHaven**, who chips in 12.2 ppg, but the Tribe relies mostly on balanced scoring. Five players average more than eight points per contest, including reserve **Kyra Kaylor**, who averages 8.3 ppg. Kaylor also leads the team in rebounding, nabbing 8.3 boards per game.

As a team, the Tribe shoot 42 percent and more than 33 percent from behind the arc. **Kelly Ercole** is the team's sharpshooter, hitting nine of her 32 attempts from three-point range (.391). Meanwhile, DeHaven leads the squad in assists, dishing 28 dimes on the season.

## DISHING THE ROCK

Senior guard **Kaitlin Schuyler** has 250 assists in her three-plus seasons at AU, good for seventh all-time. She is just 13 assists from sixth-place. Schuyler passed out a career-high 83 assists (3.5 apg) in the 2001-02 season, and followed that up with 75 assists in 29 games (2.6 apg) last year. In her freshman campaign, Schuyler dished out 65 assists in 23 games (2.8 apg). For her career, Schuyler has given out 2.9 assists per game. If she continues on that pace, Schuyler has a chance to move into fourth place on the school's all-time career assists list, behind Danielle Blackburn (340), Karen Jenkins (396) and the school's all-time leader, Jody Thornton, who had 693 assists between 1983 and 1987. Schuyler leads to 2003-04 Eagles with 27 assists, including tallying seven dimes versus Mount St. Mary's. In addition, she has turned the ball over just 23 times this season.

## COMING ALIVE FROM BEHIND THE ARC

Although the Eagles last season were the best defensive team in school history, it is no secret that the Eagles struggled to shoot from three-point range, hitting just 25 percent of their three-point attempts. However, through AU's first six games, the Eagles are hitting nearly 36 percent of their attempts from behind the arc. In fact, AU has outshot all seven of its opponents from behind the three-point line. Leading the way is junior reserve **Angel Jordan**, who has hit five of her 11 three point attempts this season. Meanwhile, **Angel McNatt**, who came into this season as a 20 percent career three-point shooter, has hit 40 percent of her attempts this season.

## EVERYONE CONTRIBUTES

Eleven of the 13 active players on the American University roster -- junior **Tala Hadavi** is sitting out this season due to NCAA transfer rules -- have seen action in all five of the Eagles' games so far this season. Junior **Jenyce Woodruff** has become somewhat of a "super sub," averaging nearly 17 minutes per game and shooting .583 (7-of-12) from the field. **Chanel Spriggs** leads the Eagles in minutes played, with Head Coach **Shann Hart** choosing to keep her senior co-captain on the floor for 197 of the 240 minutes played.

## WE PLAY, SHE STARTS

Senior shooting guard **Chanel Spriggs** has played in 62 games for American University since transferring from Div. III St. Mary's (Md.) after her freshman season (following the footsteps of Head Coach **Shann Hart**), and has started in each of those games. In addition to setting the school's all-time record for steals, Spriggs has scored 674 points in her two-plus seasons (10.9 ppg), hit nearly 48 percent of her shots and grabbed 296 rebounds (4.9 rpg).

## PAST SUCCESS = FUTURE SUCCESS?

If past results against the Eagles 2003-04 opponents are any indication of future performance, AU should have a successful season. The Eagles have a combined 102-51 (.667) record against the opponents on this season's schedule, and have a winning record when playing 13 of their 16 opponents which they have previously played. The Eagles records against 2003-04 opponents are as follows: Army, 4-3; Brown, 5-4; Bucknell, 6-3; Colgate, 5-1; Elon, 0-1; Holy Cross, 0-5; Howard, 8-6; Lafayette, 10-0; Lehigh, 7-2; Liberty, 4-0; Loyola (Md.), 6-2; UMBC, 5-3; UMES, 8-1; Mt. St. Mary's, 4-5; Navy, 10-7; and William & Mary, 26-11.

## STREAKING

Senior shooting guard **Kaitlin Schuyler** is on a four-game hot streak. Against Mount St. Mary's on Dec. 3, the 5-7 Maryland native chipped in 15 points, seven assists, three steals and two rebounds. Schuyler then found Arizona's gym to her liking, scoring 13 points versus Arizona in the first round of the Fiesta Bowl Classic and contributing 13 points, three assists, two rebounds and a steal versus Utah St. in the consolation game. Against UMBC, Schuyler contributed 12 points, five assists and four steals and shot three-of-five from behind the three-point line. Overall, Schuyler is averaging 10.1 ppg, 3.9 apg and 2.0 rpg.
