The Coaches

American University is coached by **Shann Hart** (Norfolk State '88), who is in her fourth season leading the Eagles, and seventh overall as a collegiate head coach. Hart has a career record of 115-83 [.581]. Hart led American to 18 wins last season, the most since the 1997-98 season. She is assisted by **Glenn Rigney** (Miami '79), **Deb Reardon** (Assumption '86), **Brian Johnson** (Drexel '98) and graduate manager **Quintina Walker** (William & Mary '02).

Elon is coached by **Brenda Paul** (North Georgia '77), who is in her 10th season with the Phoenix. Paul owns a career record of 401-337 (.543), including a 121-138 (.467) record at Elon. Paul is assisted by **Ann Lashley** (Mississippi St. '89), **Shelly Katkowski** (Pittsburgh '01) and **Susan Edwards** (Western Illinois '96).

AMERICAN UNIVERSITY WOMEN'S BASKETBALL



LAST TIME OUT

Chanel Spriggs' 13 points, seven rebounds and five steals were not enough for the American University women's basketball team in a 72-58 loss to William & Mary on Dec. 20 at William & Mary Hall in Williamsburg, Va.

Despite shooting just 34 percent in the first stanza, American used stingy defense – holding the Tribe to just 36 percent shooting and forcing 11 W&M turnovers – to stay within three at halftime.

W&M scored the first five points of the second half to pull ahead by eight, but AU came back to within three points on a three-pointer by senior guard **Kaitlin Schuyler** at the 11:11 mark. Schuyler's trey was her third of the game and 106th of her career, which vaulted her into second place all-time at American in career three-pointers made.

However, the Tribe then went on a 17-3 run over the next six minutes to take a 64-48 lead. The Eagles came no closer than eight points for the remainder of the game. American's 25.7 percent shooting in the second half – compared to the Tribe's 65 percent shooting in the period – precluded any hope of a comeback.

Schuyler finished with 12 points, five boards and three assists. Junior forward **Chanel Hunt** added 12 points and six rebounds.

THE OPPONENT AND THE HISTORY

This is just the second meeting of American University and the Phoenix of Elon University. Elon captured the first meeting on Dec. 30, 2002, 70-55, on its home court. Elon enters this evening's contest at 4-5, with wins against William & Mary (57-49), Longwood (75-62), Youngstown St. (63-58) and Appalachian St. (79-75). The Phoenix's losses were to No. 4 Duke (108-26), Villanova (66-45), North Carolina A&T (78-63), Chattanooga (84-58) and East Tennessee St. (64-54).

ON THIS DATE

The Eagles defeated Vermont, 80-69, on Dec. 30, 1983, for their first win of the season. AU had begun the season with eight consecutive losses, but the victory over Vermont launched a five-game win streak.

SPRIGGS SETS SCHOOL CAREER STEALS RECORD

With her six steals versus UMBC on Dec. 18, senior guard **Chanel Spriggs** took over the top spot in American University school history in career steals, breaking the record of former Eagle Jody Thornton, who had 244 steals between 1983 and 1987. As of Dec. 15, Spriggs was averaging 3.7 steals per game, good for 14th in the NCAA.

Spriggs 110 steals in the 2001-2002 season set the school's single-season record for most steals. She established new AU, Patriot League and Bender Arena records with 11 steals against Holy Cross on Jan. 26, 2003. In addition, after her 33 steals in eight games this season, Spriggs cracked into the top-10 for career steals in Patriot League history. Lafayette's Heidi Caruso, who played for the Leopards between 1990 and 1994, holds the Patriot League career steals record with 354.

UP NEXT

American hits the highway on New Year's Day for a Jan. 2 matchup against Brown. Tip-off against the Bears is set for 4 p.m.

HOME, SWEET HOME

AU women's basketball has accumulated a 116-77 (.601) record in the friendly confines of Bender Arena, since the facility opened its doors on Jan. 23, 1988. American has had a winning home record in 12 of the last 13 seasons, going 102-51 (.667) during that span. Last season, the Eagles racked up 10 wins against just two losses in Bender. American hosts 12 regular season home games this season. The Eagles opened up Bender in style so far this season, with wins over UNC Asheville and Howard.

THAT'S THE TICKET!

American's five wins in eight games this season have all come when the Eagles shoot .400 or better. In AU's three losses -- at Loyola, at Arizona and at William & Mary -- American shot just .373, .379 and .299.

THREE-POINT THREAT

With three three-point field goals versus William & Mary on Dec. 20, senior guard **Kaitlin Schuyler** moved into second all-time on the school's career three-point field goals made list. The three treys gave her 106 in her career, surpassing 2003 graduate Maria Werries, who had 105, for second place. Schuyler would have to hit more than two three-pointers per game for the remaining 19 regular season contests to surpass the school record of 147 three-pointers made, set by Kari Gaskins between 1995 and 1999. This season, Schuyler is averaging 1.75 three-pointers made per game. For her career, she is averaging 1.26 three-pointers per game.

PATRIOT LEAGUE PRESEASON PREDICTIONS

American has been selected by the Patriot League's coaches and sports information directors to finish second in the league. Ten-time Patriot League regular season champion Holy Cross was selected to win the league this year. The Crusaders were a near-unanimous selection to win the regular season title, with 14 out of a possible 16 first-place votes and 98 points. The Eagles were selected second with 84 points.

Meanwhile, junior forward **Chanel Hunt** was selected by the league's coaches and SIDs to the 2003-04 Preseason All-Patriot League Team. She was joined by Courtney Davidson from Navy, Katie Macfarlane from Army, Maggie Fontana from Holy Cross and Desire Almind from Bucknell. Hunt was among the league leaders last season in scoring (14.4 ppg), rebounding (7.3 rpg), assists (2.5 apg), steals (2.5 spg) and field goal percentage (.507).

HUNT(ING) 1,000 POINTS

After eight games this season, junior forward **Chanel Hunt** has 726 career points (11.3 ppg), including 417 points last season (14.4 ppg). Hunt needs to average 14.4 ppg over the 19 remaining regular season games to reach the 274 points needed to attain 1,000 career points. Hunt is averaging 9.5 ppg so far this season. If Hunt can attain her 14.4 ppg scoring average from last season, she will score her 1,000th point on Feb. 20, 2004, at home against Holy Cross. Hunt would be just the 11th Eagle in school history to reach four-digits in scoring. Felicia Young is the school's all-time leading scorer, with 1,708 points.

Scouting Report

Elon: The Phoenix use a short bench -- with just eight players playing in all nine of their games -- but all eight contribute, averaging more than 20 minutes per game. Elon is led offensively by **Holly Andrews**, who is averaging 18.2 ppg. Just one other player -- 6-5 senior center **Courtney Nyborg** -- averages in double-digits. Nyborg chips in 10.8 ppg, 4.7 rpg and has blocked 19 shots thus far. **Brianne Gray** leads the Phoenix in rebounding, with 6.2 rpg, and shooting, hitting at a 52 percent clip. Andrews and **Jessica Williams** combine to formulate Elon's outside threat, hitting 33 of the Phoenix's 43 treys on the season. Andrews has hit 40 percent of her three-point attempts (18-of-45), while Williams has hit 30 percent (15-of-50).

The streaky Phoenix have not won more than two games in a row so far, nor have they lost more than three in a row.

DISHING THE ROCK

Senior guard **Kaitlin Schuyler** has 253 assists in her three-plus seasons at AU, good for seventh all-time. She is just 10 assists from sixth-place. Schuyler passed out a career-high 83 assists (3.5 apg) in the 2001-02 season, and followed that up with 75 assists in 29 games (2.6 apg) last year. In her freshman campaign, Schuyler dished out 65 assists in 23 games (2.8 apg). For her career, Schuyler has given out 3.0 assists per game. If she continues on that pace, Schuyler has a chance to move into fourth place on the school's all-time career assists list, behind Danielle Blackburn (340), Karen Jenkins (396) and the school's all-time leader, Jody Thornton, who had 693 assists between 1983 and 1987. Schuyler leads the 2003-04 Eagles with 30 assists, including tallying seven dimes versus Mount St. Mary's. In addition, she has turned the ball over just 25 times this season.

COMING ALIVE FROM BEHIND THE ARC

Although the Eagles last season were the best defensive team in school history, it is no secret that the Eagles struggled to shoot from three-point range, hitting just 25 percent of their three-point attempts. However, through AU's first eight games, the Eagles are hitting more than 32 percent of their attempts from behind the arc. In fact, AU has outshot all six of its opponents from behind the three-point line. Leading the way are junior reserve **Angel Jordan** and senior reserve **Angel McNatt**, who have both hit six of their 16 attempts on the season (.375).

EVERYONE CONTRIBUTES

Eleven of the 13 active players on the American University roster -- junior **Tala Hadavi** is sitting out this season due to NCAA transfer rules -- have seen action in all eight of the Eagles' games so far this season. Junior **Jenyce Woodruff** has become somewhat of a "super sub," averaging nearly 15 minutes per game. **Chanel Spriggs** leads the Eagles in minutes played, with Head Coach **Shann Hart** choosing to keep her senior co-captain on the floor for 269 of the 320 minutes played.

WE PLAY, SHE STARTS

Senior shooting guard **Chanel Spriggs** has played in 63 games for American University since transferring from Div. III St. Mary's (Md.) after her freshman season (following the footsteps of Head Coach **Shann Hart**), and has started in each of those games. In addition to closing in on the school's all-time record for steals, Spriggs has scored 687 points in her two-plus seasons (10.9 ppg), hit nearly 48 percent of her shots and grabbed 310 rebounds (4.9 rpg).

PAST SUCCESS = FUTURE SUCCESS?

If past results against the Eagles 2003-04 opponents are any indication of future performance, AU should have a successful season. The Eagles have a combined 102-51 (.667) record against the opponents on this season's schedule, and have a winning record when playing 13 of their 16 opponents which they have previously played. The Eagles records against 2003-04 opponents are as follows: Army, 4-3; Brown, 5-4; Bucknell, 6-3; Colgate, 5-1; Elon, 0-1; Holy Cross, 0-5; Howard, 8-6; Lafayette, 10-0; Lehigh, 7-2; Liberty, 4-0; Loyola (Md.), 6-2; UMBC, 5-3; UMES, 8-1; Mt. St. Mary's, 4-5; Navy, 10-7; and William & Mary, 26-11.

AMERICAN VERSUS THE LEAGUE

American University women's basketball is ranked in the top three of nine of 19 statistical categories the Patriot League calculates. The Eagles are the top team in the PL in scoring defense (allowing 57.4 ppg), three-point field goal percentage defense (allowing opponents to shoot just .248 from behind the arc), rebound defense (allowing opponents to grab 34.0 rpg, more than three rebounds better than the second-place team), steals (grabbing 12.88 per game) and turnover margin (with a whopping +3.75 differential between turnovers and turnovers forced). In addition, AU ranks second in the league in three-point field goal percentage (.324) and offensive rebounds (13.75 per game) and third in three-point field goals made (4.25 per game) and scoring margin (outscored opponents by 5.4 ppg)
