

Which Applied Music Course Number Should I Sign Up For???

MUS-021

Non-credit private instrument and vocal lessons for 1/2 hour per week. The course fee is \$550.00 per semester.

MUS-022

Non-credit private instrument and vocal lessons for 1 hour per week. The course fee is \$1,100.00 per semester.

MUS-121

One credit private instrument and vocal lessons for 1/2 hour per week. The course fee is \$150.00 per semester plus regular tuition. See requirements for registering for lessons for credit.

MUS-122

Two credit private instrument and vocal lessons for 1 hour per week. The course fee is \$250.00 per semester plus regular tuition. See requirements for registering for lessons for credit.

MUS-334

Four credit private instrument and vocal junior recital course. Please consult the Director of Music, x3427, or Applied Music Coordinator for more information.

MUS-434

Four credit private instrument and vocal senior recital course. Please consult the Director of Music, x3427, or Applied Music Coordinator for more information.

MUS-791

For graduate students, one credit private instrument and vocal lessons for 1/2 hour per week. The course fee is \$150.00 per semester plus regular tuition. See requirements for registering for lessons for credit.

MUS-792

For graduate students, two credit private instrument and vocal lessons for 1 hour per week. The course fee is \$250.00 per semester plus regular tuition. See requirements for registering for lessons for credit.

****NB:** All students registering for Applied Music (MUS-121, 122, 334, 434) must register for and attend AMPL, a mandatory Applied Music Performance Lab (MUS-001). This zero credit lab is scheduled for Wednesdays from 12:45-2:00pm in the Katzen building's Abramson Family Recital Hall, Room 160. Requirements for all registrants will be provided by your instructor as part of your Applied Music syllabus. Students take this course as a Pass/Fail option only.
