1. Time to Completion (Students graduating in 2002-2008)
 - a. Mean Number of Years: 6.43
 - b. Median Number of Years: 6
 - c. % of students completing the program in:
 - i. Under 5 years: 2%
 - ii. 5 years: 28%
 - iii. 6 years: 32%
 - iv. 7 years: 19%
 - v. More than 7 years: 19%

2. Program Cost (2008-2009)
 - a. Full time Tuition: \$21,204.00 per year; Part-time Tuition (per credit hr): \$1,178.00; Fees beyond Tuition: \$65 Sports Center Fee, \$95 Student Technology Fee, \$30 Graduate Activity Fee.
 - b. For 2008-2009, full tuition remission plus a \$12,000 fellowship, plus a teaching assistantship of \$7,488 was provided to 4 first year students. Total funding for the year, including tuition remission, is \$40,692.00

3. Internships: (2001-01 to 2007-08)
 - a. 47 of 54, 87% obtained internships on first application
 - b. 49 students obtained paid internships
 - c. 48/49 obtained APPIC internships
 - d. 45/49 received APA accredited internships
(Of the three students who did not match on first application, before the 2006-07 application year, 3 (100%) matched on the second application; two students from the 2006-2007 application cohort who did not match on first application, matched on second application in 2007-08).
 - e. 1/10 students in the 2007-2008 cohort obtained a two year, half time internship.

4. Attrition: Between AY's 2002-03 and 2007-08, 46 students matriculated into the program. Two students left the program since 2002. The attrition rate is 4%.
5. Licensing Data: Between 1997-2006, 59 students graduated from our doctoral program. For the 48 students for whom we have information, 42 students (87.5%) passed, no students (0%) failed, and 6 students (12.5%) have not yet taken the exam.
