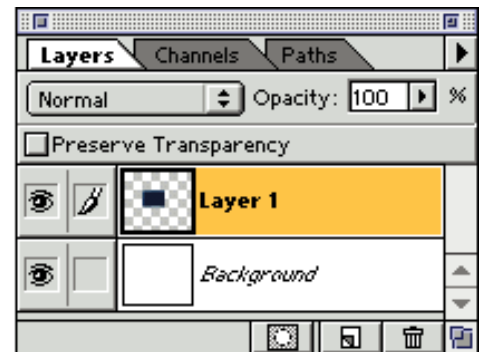

Upper Menu Bar

The option menu bar at the top of the interface contains the palettes (color, layers, navigator), image rendering effects, guides, and filters.

Layers Palette



The layers palette helps you to organize your images by keeping elements separate and editable individually. To add a layer, you can click the "add new layer" button or choose "new" then "layer" from the layer menu option.

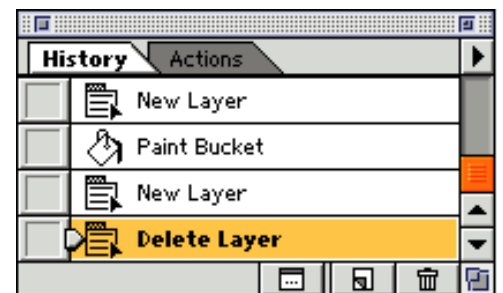
Toolbar



The upper area of the toolbar is made of tools that create and edit images and graphics (lines, squares, lasso, and eraser) and to create text. Some of these tools have multiple options indicated by the small triangle in the lower right corner next to the tool icon.

The lower area of the toolbar can assist in choosing your background and foreground colors, quick mask mode editing, and viewing options.

History Palette



The history palette allows you to see what tools and effects you have used on your image. If you choose to delete one of your previous steps, click on the action you do not want and drag it to the trash can icon at the bottom of the palette.
